Together with DP World Tour sanctioning, the ISPS HANDA Australian Open is now a signature event on the world's stage.

The action will take place on the world-renowned Melbourne Sandbelt from December 1-4, with Victoria Golf Club the primary host venue across all four days of the tournament and Kingston Heath Golf Club set to co-host the first two days of play.

The two host venues for the ISPS HANDA Australian Open's return are located in the heart of the world-famous Melbourne Sandbelt in Cheltenham, Victoria and are regarded as two of the finest golf courses in the country. The superbly crafted greens and bunkers of both venues bring out the best in the world's top players and that is why many of the game's greatest have triumphed at Victoria and Kingston Heath in the past.

The Men's Australian Open is one of the oldest golf tournaments in the world, dating to 1904, and has been won by golf immortals such as Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, Peter Thomson, Greg Norman, Tom Watson, Bobby Locke, Gene Sarazen, along with modern superstars Rory McIlroy, Jordan Spieth and Adam Scott, all world No. 1 players.

WOMEN'S AUSTRALIAN OPEN

The Women's Australian Open returns to Melbourne for the first time since 2015 after five successful events in Adelaide. The event was first played in 1974 and established itself as a world-class event in Adelaide over recent years, with three different world No. 1 players taking out the past three events Jin Young Ko, Nelly Korda and Inbee Park.

A field of 144 women will compete across four days and two venues in contention for the Patricia Bridges Bowl and a share of \$1.7m prizemoney.

The third edition of the Australian All Abilities Championship will assemble the top 12 players on the World Ranking for Golfers with Disability (WR4GD) from across the world supported by global partners EDGA, the International Golf Federation and newly formed G4D Tour.

Players will compete for the Championship trophy at Victoria Golf Club 2-4 December.

When the event was introduced in 2018 it was the first of its kind and put the Championship at the forefront of promoting sport for people with disabilities. It strongly supports the movement to include Para-Golf within the Paralympics sports program.
