

Golf Australia High Performance Program Education Policy

The Golf Australia (GA) High Performance Program (HPP) Education policy is outlined below. The policy ensures that GA HPP athletes benefit from a more well-rounded development that prepares them for success both on and off the course.

Policy Requirements:

- A requirement for athletes to have completed, or be in the process of completing, their Secondary Certificate of Education, as recognised by the education department in their respective State or Territory, to ensure they have the necessary education and skills to succeed in life beyond sport.
- Provisions for athletes who leave secondary school early for an approved apprenticeship which meets the standards of the Australia Qualifications Framework to allow them to gain valuable vocational training whilst still pursuing their athletic goals.
- Support for athletes to balance their academic and athletic commitments, such as time management skills training, counselling, and/or designate study sessions when travelling in organised events.
