It has been an integral part of the Australian Junior golfing calendar since 1972. Mr Gary Player has been a supporter of this event since its inception.

Gary Player is a South African retired professional golfer who is widely considered to be one of the greatest golfers ever. During his career, Player won nine major championships on the regular tour and nine major championships on the Champions Tour. Gary Player supports Junior Golf in Queensland and provides playing opportunities to young golfers.
