Affiliates	 Companies (financial and nonfinancial) related by common ownership or control. While Policygenius does not currently have affiliates, we reserve the right to share your information with any future affiliates as described on page 1 of this notice.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies (financial and nonfinancial) not related by common ownership or control. T These may include insurance carriers, service providers, joint marketing partners, and others.
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance carriers, brokers, agents, business partners, and others.
