

2013 & 2015

In Sofia, Bulgaria, our team revitalized a school for visually impaired children. In Plovdiv, we helped refurbish an orphanage.

2016

TELUS International Europe Community Board doubled in size and scope, forming the TELUS International Bulgaria Community Board and the TELUS International Romania Community Board, which each contribute US\$100,000 annually. And, more than 1,200 team members volunteered for the TELUS Days of Giving.

2015

TELUS International Europe Community Board was founded. In Romania, our teams renovated schools in both Bucharest and Craiova, replacing furniture, painting and improving the schools for over 400 children.

2018

India

2018

The first ever TELUS Days of Giving were held in New Delhi, India. The largest events had more than 1,000 participants: a 'ride for child rights' cyclothon, which helped keep 3,695 underprivileged children in school, and a learning center refurbishment, which improves the quality of education for 2,400 children.
