Our team is continuously monitoring all developments, rules and regulations in ports worldwide. Following the WHO guidelines, we ask you to respect our rules and safety measures to protect both yourself and our team and stay healthy whilst we operate in a responsible manner.



- For your safety and ours we need to keep the people on board to an absolute minimum (both in port and at sea), therefore the number of riders is at the Captain's and owners discretion (following the company's Covid-19 regulations)

- In addition to previous point: make sure your yacht is clean and ready for transport before loading. Remove your own waste, clean all railings, door handles, etc with disinfectant soap or gel.



- Please wear gloves.



- Check in with your loadmaster by phone. All communications through phone.



- Ship's accommodation is only accessible with Captain's permission.



- Please fill out our 'Coronavirus identification form for boarding'.

## FURTHERMORE WE ASK YOU TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS TOO:



Keep a minimum distance of 1,5 m



Cover your cough  
When using tissues:  
throw them in waste bin



Clean & disinfect frequently touched objects & surfaces  
Alternatively use alcohol-based sanitizer with min. 60% alcohol



Apply hygienic recommendations



Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth



Wash your hands with soap & water for 20 seconds, after using bathroom, before eating and after blowing nose, coughing or sneezing
