1. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Anyone considering submitting an entry to participate in this sweepstakes should read all of the information below for eligibility rules, requirements of participation and an explanation of the prizes. Two winners will be chosen in a random drawing on April 21, 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. By entering the sweepstakes, participant accepts and agrees to be bound by these rules and by the decision of the Sponsor, which shall be final and binding in all respects. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any person or social media post that Sponsor determines to be in violation of any term contained in these Official Rules. Sponsor reserves the right to modify these rules for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the sweepstakes. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel this sweepstakes at any time without obligation or prior notice. This sweepstakes is open to persons age 18 and over, who are legal residents of the United States and each of whom complies with the additional requirements set forth in these Official Rules. Void where prohibited or restricted by applicable federal or state laws and regulations.

2. TO ENTER

To enter this sweepstakes, visit the Clackamas River, take a photo of your fishing experience or of your catch (wild or hatchery steelhead, caught following all fishing [rules and regulations](#), as described by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife), join our [Environmental Community Facebook Group](#), and post your photo using the hashtag #ClackOnTrack. **Photos must demonstrate proper fish handling, and any photos showing wild steelhead out of the water may be removed.**

Submitted photos will not be accepted or eligible and may be removed from Facebook if, in the sole discretion of Sponsor’s Social Media Manager, they include any content that contains or appears to contain:

- Explicitly profane or obscene material;
- Endorsement (or condones) of illegal drug use, alcohol abuse or other illegal activity;
- Nudity, profanity or extreme or gratuitous violence;
- Any express or implied commercial endorsement;
- Any derogatory characterization of any person or group based on age, race, color, gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, religious beliefs, marital



status, mental or physical disability, citizenship, creed, national origin, physical appearance, political affiliation, union membership, or other unethical or unlawful factors; or

- Depictions of any conduct, language or other context deemed inappropriate by the Sponsor or in violation of our Facebook group's policies.
- Depictions that suggest fish were caught in violation of fishing [rules and regulations](#) as described by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To enter and to be eligible to receive a prize, participants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- must be age 18 and over;
- must be a legal resident of the United States;

Upon selection, winner may be asked to provide proof of age. If at any point during the sweepstakes Sponsor deems an entry ineligible, Sponsor may disqualify that entry and at its sole discretion, select an alternate. You do not need to reside in the service territory of the Sponsor.

4. SELECTION PROCESS

Sponsor will select a winning entry from random drawing of entries on April 21, 2020, from all eligible entries received. The drawing will have two winners — one grand-prize winner and one second-place winner. Odds of winning vary and depend on the number of eligible entries received.

Only one entry per person will be considered in the drawing — multiple entries do not increase odds of winning.

5. PRIZE PACKAGES

Two winning entries will be selected through a random drawing to receive a prize.

The grand-prize winner will receive: One \$50 gift certificate to Sportsman's Warehouse, a PGE dry bag, and a free two-night stay at PGE's Promontory Park campground.

The second-place winner will receive: A PGE insulated dry bag and a free two-night stay at PGE's Promontory Park campground.



Winners are solely responsible for the payment of any and all taxes and/or fees that may be incurred as a result of prizes awarded.
