Following this work, we will be making some security and fencing improvements within the substation property.

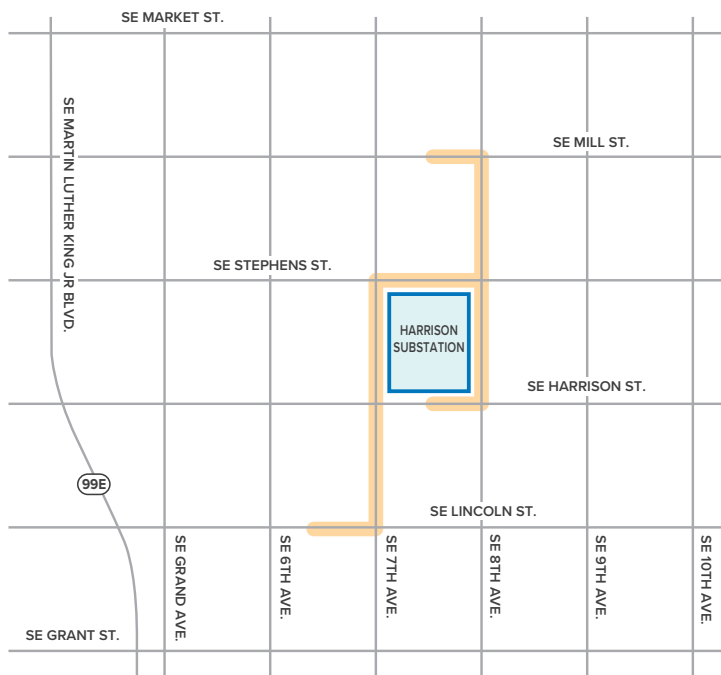
## Anticipated power line construction schedule:

- 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday
- September through December 2019

## What can you expect during this work?

You'll see crews from our contractor, Extreme, completing improvements to our overhead and underground lines. In preparation for this work, trees and other landscaping will be trimmed or removed, and sidewalks will be intermittently closed.

At times, we'll need to park some equipment on the street overnight and we may require street parking to conduct our work in a safe manner.

### We're taking steps to ensure your safety. Here's how you can help:

- **Watch for temporary lane closures and detours.** Allow for extra time for commuting through these areas.
- **Watch for "no parking" signs.** At times, we'll need to reserve space for truck deliveries, equipment parking and to keep you and your vehicle safe.
- **Follow directions from any flaggers, detours and signs** used to keep drivers, cyclists, pedestrians and workers safe.
- **Please avoid all work areas and equipment,** and make sure children know to never touch the equipment.
