

Pacific Northwest consortium named as a regional clean energy hydrogen hub



PGE WILL CONTINUE TO PARTNER
WITH THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST
HYDROGEN ASSOCIATION (PNWH2),
TO EXPLORE CLEAN HYDROGEN
PRODUCTION TO HELP MEET
OREGON'S CLEAN ENERGY TARGETS.

The PNWH2 Hub was selected to begin award negotiations with the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Clean Energy Demonstrations (OCED) as part of this cutting-edge clean energy opportunity, marking the first step in a multi-year process to affirm hydrogen project feasibility, affordability, and impacts. PGE's project concept would utilize the site of the former Boardman Coal Plant, which was demolished in 2022, to locate a potential new facility to produce clean hydrogen to generate clean electricity, continuing PGE's investment in eastern Oregon.
