

Which vehicle types make up your fleet?

GVWR: 6,001 – 10,000 lbs

GVWR: 6,001 – 10,000 lbs

GVWR: 16,001 – 19,500 lbs

GVWR: > 33,000 lbs

GVWR: 19,501 – 33,000 lbs



○ **Class 8: Fire Truck**
GVWR: > 33,000 lbs



○ **Class 6/7: Type C/D School Bus**
GVWR: 19,501 – 33,000 lbs



○ **Class 8: Refuse Truck**
GVWR: > 33,000 lbs
