
2024 Green Future Impact historic product content label



Green Future Impact is a bundled Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) product² sold in kilowatt-hours (kWh). Renewable Energy Certificates do not contain electricity, which is billed separately. A REC represents the environmental benefits of 1 megawatt-hour (MWh) of renewable energy.
