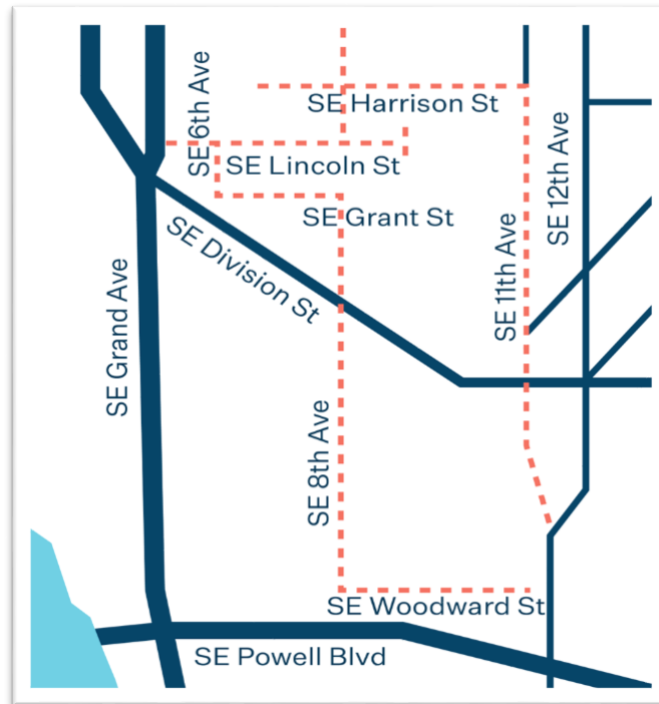
Distribution Line upgrade near Harrison Substation

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Starting in late-April, Portland General Electric will upgrade a distribution line from the Harrison Substation. We'll be replacing some power poles and upgrading wires to improve service and reliability for customers in Southeast Portland.

WHERE THE WORK WILL TAKE PLACE

- The south end of the project will run along SE Woodward Street, from SE Milwaukie to SE 8th Avenue.
- From there, the line goes north on SE 8th Avenue and SE 11th Avenue up to SE Stephens Street.
- The project's north end includes parts of SE Grant Street, SE Lincoln Street and SE Harrison Street between SE 11th Avenue and SE Grand Avenue.



WHY THIS PROJECT IS NEEDED

- This project is part of our ongoing effort to make service more reliable for customers in Southeast Portland.
- We expect these upgrades will help reduce both how often and how long unplanned outages last.
- The upgrades will also make it easier for us to switch power sources and better serve customers.

WHAT TO EXPECT AND WHEN

- PGE is working with the city to keep disruptions to a minimum.
- To keep everyone safe, there may be some planned power outages. Log in to your account at portlandgeneral.com to ensure your contact info is up to date so we can inform you of any power disruptions in advance.
- You might hear construction noise in the area.
