













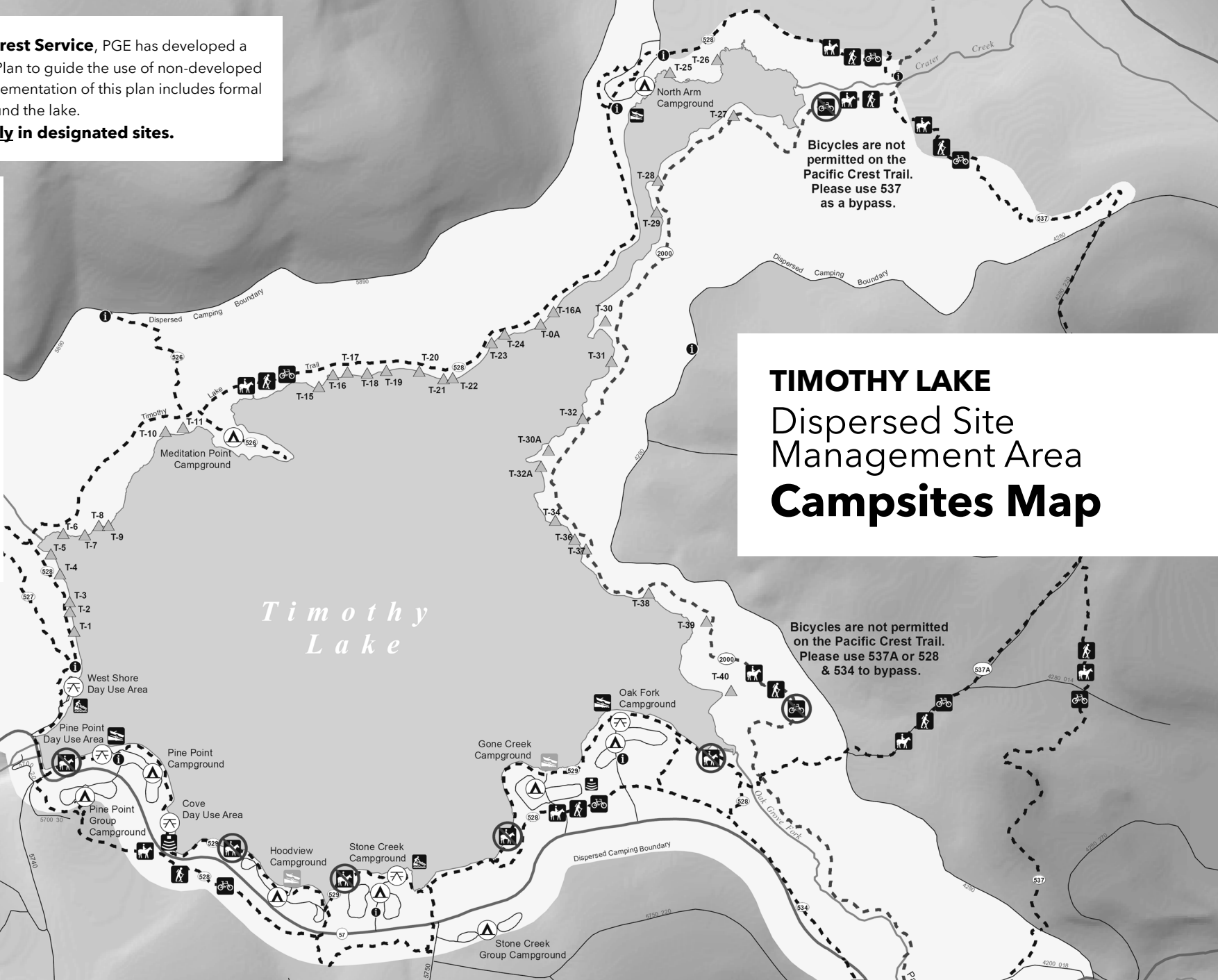

Camping is permitted only in designated sites.

PARKING & FEES:

DESIGNATED SITE

Camping Rules

Permit required for camping in designated dispersed sites located within the Timothy Lake Management Area.

- Camping is only allowed in campgrounds and designated dispersed sites.
- Trailside campsite posts indicate routes to designated campsite locations.
- Maximum occupancy for sites is 6 persons.
- Campfires are allowed within designated sites only, use existing fire rings.
- Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun is prohibited.
- Pack it in – Pack it out. All garbage, food, and belongings must be removed from site and properly disposed of when vacating site.
- Deposit human waste by digging a cathole 6+ inches deep, 200+ feet from water, camp, and trails.
- Pets must be on leash no more than 6 feet long and under control at all times.
- Maximum of two 14 consecutive day stays per year with a 30+ day break between.

These rules are enforceable under Title 36 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Violations are subject to fine or penalty.
