When to apply

Positions are posted in January and applications will be accepted until positions are filled. Please apply by February 17, 2023 to make sure your application is competitively considered.

Internship Functions:

- IT (Quality Assurance, Developers - JavaScript/ React & AWS)
- Engineering
- Project Management / Business Analysis

Internship Dates:

- May/June to August/September 2023

PGE supports hybrid flexible arrangements, and these roles will have a combination of working in-the-office and offsite, determined by the manager and team needs.

Internship Requirements

- At least 18 years old as of June 1, 2023
- A high school graduate (GED accepted also) who is college or trade bound (including community college, trade or technical institutes), or...
- A full-time (a minimum of 12 credit hours) college student who is returning to college or trade school in the fall of the current year or...
- A college graduate of the current school year.

When applying to a specific internship position, you will be asked to submit verification of your student status (one of the following items):

- Your college transcript (an unofficial one is acceptable)
- Your latest college or school grade report
- Your acceptance letter from a college level program or
- A letter from a high school counselor about your college or trade school plans for fall
