¹ "Ducted" means a system that delivers heated or cooled air via a duct system, with vents typically located in the ceiling or floor. Electric forced air furnaces are a common example of ducted heating systems. Boilers, baseboards, cadet/wall heaters, ductless heat pumps/mini-splits are examples of heating or cooling systems that are non-ducted.

² "Permanently installed Wi-Fi network" means a Wi-Fi network that is installed and always available for regular daily use by you, your customers, or your business partners. A mobile hotspot, for example, isn't permanent because such networks are typically only turned on when the device owner is present.
