1. This is related to the discussion about the types of CBIs (rCBI, pCBI, and iCBI) and how those metrics are used. Thank you for the clear explanation at the previous meeting. I understand how it works in the IRP context, but I was wondering how community benefits are used in the CEP. As required by HB 2021 and the Oregon Court of Appeals, the CEP is required to include a discussion of the HB 2021 policy statement. (For more information on the Court of Appeals decision, please look at this document that we filed in PacifiCorp's IRP/CEP proceeding: <https://edocs.puc.state.or.us/efdocs/HAO/lc85hao343130037.pdf> [edocs.puc.state.or.us]) Many of the CBIs that were included in the presentation (slides 59-60) would align with the goals of the HB 2021 policy statement, but I have not seen any materials discussing how these would be applied to the CEP. I look forward to future engagement on this and other topics. Thank you!

PGE Response:

The CBI framework presented in the January roundtable meeting is also applicable to the CEP's consideration of community benefits. The May 20, 2026 Roundtable will also discuss CBIs and provide more information on how PGE will quantify CBIs moving forward. Continued engagement on CBIs will inform the 2026 CEP/IRP.
