REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL ("RFP")

Transmission Line Owner's Engineer Services for the Warm Springs Power Pathway Project

THIS RFP AMENDMENT #2 IS RAISED TO:

- 1. Respond to questions and answers;
- 2. Amend the Statement of Work ("SOW") in Annex A of the RFP;
- 3. Amend the Mandatory Evaluation Criteria in Annex C of the RFP; and
- 4. Amend the Point-Rated Evaluation Criteria in Annex D of the RFP.

THIS RFP AMENDMENT #2 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **DELETE** section 4.1.1 of the SOW on page 20 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - 4.1.1 Other services may include permitting and regulatory and Tribal compliance support, geotechnical investigations, construction planning and sequencing before the 90% design package is complete (e.g. locating pull sites and work areas, spotting structures in constructable locations, any sequencing considerations to rebuild the 230 kV as double circuit, etc.).
- 2. **ADD** section 4.5.3 to section 4.5 Insulator Assembly Design on page 21 of the RFP:
 - 4.5.3 For the ADSS cables, the Contractor shall utilize PGE's standard ADSS fiber hardware assemblies. The Contractor may request modifications to these assemblies from the PGE Contract Administrator.
- 3. **DELETE** section 4.16.1 (a) of the SOW on page 26 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - 4.16.1 (a) PGE will order all long lead time material at the 60% design milestone.



- 4. **DELETE** section 4.19 of the SOW on page 28 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - 4.19 After the 90% design package is complete, the Contractor shall collaborate with PGE on developing the RFP package for an EPC Contractor, who will finalize the construction package from 90% to IFC and then procure the materials and construct the Project. The below table outlines the general responsibilities of the Contractor and PGE.

Bid Evaluation	 Answers bidders' questions during the solicitation period Facilitates the bid evaluation process by accepting the bids, sharing the bids with technical evaluators, scheduling bid evaluation consensus meetings, writing a bid evaluation summary, etc. 	- Supports PGE in answering bidders' questions during the solicitation period - Assists PGE in evaluating the technical and financial bids for an EPC Contractor, in accordance with the evaluation selection methodology in the RFP.

- 5. **ADD** sections 7.1.9 through 7.1.16 in section 7.1 PGE Data on page 29 of the RFP:
 - 7.1.9 All the ROW and Real Estate data for the existing 230kV corridor (i.e. land right documents, easements, etc.)



- 7.1.10 Any pre-identified material or laydown yards from PGE's previous projects
- 7.1.11 LiDAR specifications and list of feature codes from previous PGE projects
- 7.1.12 PGE's construction specifications and standards
- 7.1.13 PGE's standard ADSS fiber hardware assemblies
- 7.1.14 Three (3) minor geotechnical studies performed in the years 2000, 2002, and 2006.
- 7.1.15 All available steel detail drawings, including lattice tower fabrication and erection drawings.
- 7.1.16 Existing 500kV hardware drawings
- 6. **DELETE** 5. Lattice Tower Performance Report #1 (see Section 0) from c. 30% Milestone (~2027) on page 27 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - Lattice Tower Performance Report #1 (see Section 4.10.2.ii)
- 7. **DELETE** 3. Lattice Tower Performance Report #2 (see Section 0) from d. 60% Milestone (~2027/2028) on page 27 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - Lattice Tower Performance Report #2 (see Section 4.10.2.ii)
- 8. **DELETE** "The Offeror must be licensed to perform overhead transmission line design and engineering services in at least one (1) U.S. state at the solicitation date" from Annex C Mandatory Evaluation Criteria on page 41 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - The Offeror must be licensed to perform overhead transmission line design and engineering services in at least one (1) U.S. state at the solicitation **closing** date.
- 9. **DELETE** "Offeror should provide between four (4) and six (6) project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (f) collectively within the last ten (10) years from the solicitation closing date," in P1 of the *Point-Rated Criteria Table* on pages 44-45 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - Offeror should provide at least four (4) different project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (f) collectively within the last ten (10) years from the solicitation closing date.
- 10. **DELETE** "Offeror should provide between two (2) and three (3) project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (d) collectively within the last ten (10) years from the solicitation closing date," in P2 of the *Point-Rated Criteria Table* on page 45 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - Offeror should provide at least three different project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (d) collectively within the last ten (10) years from the solicitation closing date. The Offeror may reuse the project examples it provided in response to P1 of the Point-Rated Criteria Table on pages 44-45 of the RFP.
- 11. **DELETE** "Offeror should provide between three (3) and four (4) project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (g) within the past ten (10) years from the solicitation closing date," in P3 of the *Point-Rated Criteria Table* on page 46 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - Offeror should provide at least three *different* project examples to demonstrate Key Personnel experience in (a) (g) collectively within the last ten (10) years from the



solicitation closing date. The Offeror may reuse the project examples it provided in response to P1 of the *Point-Rated Criteria Table* on pages 44-45 of the RFP.

- 12. **DELETE** "provide a description and examples of the Offeror's expected deliverables" in P5 of the *Point-Rated Criteria Table* on page 47 of the RFP, and **REPLACE** it with:
 - e) If the deliverables that PGE mentioned do not align with the contractor's expectation, then provide a list of the Offeror's expected deliverables.

ALL OTHER INFORMATION IN THIS RFP REMAINS THE SAME.
