

# Quick tips to save your business energy

## Lighting

- Upgrade your light bulbs to LEDs to cut energy use by up to 90%
- Install timers, controls and sensors to ensure you're only using energy when you need to be



## Hot water

- Upgrade your water heater to a heat pump water heater for 60% more efficiency than an electric one
- Lower your water heater temperature
- Insulate your pipes
- Conduct regular maintenance



## Weatherization

- Weatherize your building to save up to 20% on heating and cooling costs
- Install weather stripping around doors
- Seal up any gaps around windows, outlets and anywhere services enter the building (electrical, cable, etc.)
- Check on the insulation in roofs and walls
- Add window coverings to stay warm in the winter and cool in the summer



## Office equipment

- Upgrade to ENERGY STAR qualified equipment
- Use "smart" power strips that turn equipment off when it's not in use
- Turn off lights, computers and electronics when you leave for the night and over the weekend



## Manufacturing equipment

- Upgrade to ENERGY STAR qualified equipment
- Install variable speed drivers on motors for when you don't need full power
- Optimize compressed air systems
- Repair air leaks



## Heating, ventilation and air conditioning

- Service your system twice a year and check filters monthly
- Adjust your thermostat by just a few degrees, or let a smart thermostat determine the optimal energy-saving temperature for your business
- Use fans to keep air circulating all year long
