

2021 Heat pump offer



Details and conditions

This offer is available for ducted and ductless heat pump systems sold to PGE customers, residing in Oregon, age 21 or older, who own their home and are the customer of record located in PGE's service area where the system is installed.

Details of the offer are as outlined:

- The customer may receive a **\$200 instant discount** courtesy of a PGE-approved contractor. See below for participating contractors.
- If the customer's heat pump replaces electric resistance heat in the main area of the home, they may receive **up to \$700 cash incentive** for a ducted heat pump and **up to \$500 cash incentive** for a ductless heat pump from Energy Trust of Oregon.
- Not every installation will qualify for Energy Trust cash incentives and some installations may qualify for cash incentives of lesser or greater value. Consult Energy Trust and a participating PGE-approved contractor for details. Cash incentives are subject to change.
- Financing options are available through PGE-approved contractors.

Customers must install a qualifying heat pump system and choose from the following ducted or ductless models and participating contractors:
