A smart thermostat puts you in control and keeps your home comfortable throughout the day. Best of all, it's an easy way to be energy efficient and save on your bill.

PGE SMART THERMOSTAT PROGRAM

When you join our program, your thermostat will automatically shift some of your energy use away from peak times when demand is high. This helps us use more sustainable energy resources, lowering costs and continuing to provide you with reliable energy.

WHAT ARE PEAK TIME EVENTS?

These are times when energy demand and prices are at their highest. There are typically 5 to 6 events each season, with a maximum of 15 events.

DO I NEED TO DO ANYTHING DURING AN EVENT?

Nope! Just let your thermostat do its thing and make sure no one in your home overrides the settings. Once the event is over, your thermostat will return to its regular settings.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:



PGE calls a Peak Time Event. You will see a message on your smart thermostat or mobile app before the event.



We'll send a signal to your thermostat to pre-cool or pre-heat your home before the event starts.



During the event, your thermostat will automatically adjust by 1 to 3 degrees to temporarily reduce your energy use.



Events typically last 1 to 4 hours. You don't have to do anything, but you can change your setting any time you need to.



Your thermostat will automatically return to its regular setting after the event.

WHAT IF I GET TOO HOT OR COLD?

You're always in control of your comfort and can change your thermostat setting at any time. As long as you participate in at least half of the Peak Time Event hours, you'll get your seasonal reward.

WHAT SYSTEMS QUALIFY?

- Ducted heat pump (winter and summer)
- Electric forced-air furnace (winter)
- Central air conditioning (summer)

WHEN DO EVENTS HAPPEN?

Events may be called during the summer and winter seasons.
