## How to receive your PGE Residential EV Charging Pilot Program rebate

**Note:** Starting May 1, 2021, all new installations must be hardwired to qualify for the charger rebate.

### If submitting for the \$500 Standard Installation rebate, please send:

- Product receipt, including date of purchase and amount paid
- Installation invoice (if electrician was used)
- Permits (if applicable)
- Photo of installed charger
- Photo of serial number and model number: this can be provided via the device nameplate at the back of the charger or a screenshot with the information from your EV charger app
- Photo of the inside of your home electric panel and back panel cover after installation

### If submitting for the \$1,000 Income-Eligible Installation rebate, please send:

- Product receipt, including date of purchase and amount paid
- Installation invoice (if electrician was used)
- Permits (if applicable)
- Photo of installed charger
- Photo of your serial number and model number: this can be provided via the device nameplate at the back of the charger or a screenshot with the information from your EV charger app
- Photo of the inside of your home electric panel and back panel cover after installation
- [Income validation form](#) and proof of income listed in the form

### If submitting for the \$50 bring your own charger (BYOC) rebate, please send:

- Photo of installed charger
- Photo of your serial number and model number: this can be provided via the device nameplate at the back of the charger or a screenshot with the information from your EV charger app
- Photo of the inside of your home electric panel and back panel cover after installation
