

PGE Smart Thermostat Program Summer 2026 Sweepstakes

1. Sweepstakes Description / How to Enter: NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. PARTICIPATION CONSTITUTES PARTICIPANT'S FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT TO AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES. Sweepstakes is sponsored by Portland General Electric Company, 121 SW Salmon St., 1WTC0302, Portland, OR 97204 ("PGE").

How to be entered: You may enter sweepstakes in one of two ways:

1. You will automatically be entered in the sweepstakes if you are enrolled in PGE's Smart Thermostat Program on September 30, 2026.
2. By Mail: To enter without participating in PGE's Smart Thermostat program, legibly type or handprint on a postcard the words "PGE's **Smart Thermostat Program Summer 2026 Sweepstakes**," along with your name, address, e-mail address (if you do not have an e-mail address, print "no e-mail address") and phone number to: PGE Summer 2026 Smart Thermostat program Sweepstakes, c/o Matt Merenda, 121 SW Salmon St., 1WTC0407, Portland, OR 97204. No mechanically reproduced mail-in entries will be accepted.

Mail-in entries must be received by **11:59:59 p.m., PT, Sept. 30, 2026**. Only one entry per address will be eligible for PGE customers who enter by mail. Incorrect, partial or late entries will not be accepted. PGE reserves the right to disqualify any person or e-mail address that submits multiple entries. All entries become the exclusive property of PGE and will not be acknowledged or returned. Any submission of robotic, automatic, or programmed entries, or any entries submitted by agencies, other third parties, or through other unapproved methods are void.

2. Sweepstakes period: The sweepstakes runs from **12 p.m. PT on September 1, 2026, until 11:59:59 p.m., PT, Sept. 30, 2026**.

3. Winner selection: Ten (10) participants will be selected in a random drawing to be conducted within 30 (thirty) business days following Sept 30, 2026, from all eligible entries received. Odds of winning depend on the number of entries received. Winner will be notified by e-mail message or by phone, within five (5) business days following the drawing date.

4. Requirements of winner: Winners of the PGE Smart Thermostat Program Summer 2026 Sweepstakes must claim the prize within 10 days of notification and in the method prescribed by the notification. Winners may be required to sign and return a release of liability, declaration of eligibility, and where lawful, a publicity consent agreement, within ten (10) days after notification. Participation in the sweepstakes (e.g., sharing a photo or submitting an entry)

constitutes participant's full permission, except where prohibited by law, to use participant's submission and photo, name, city, state and age for purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity without additional compensation. If a selected potential winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the prizes within the time prescribed, or fails to return the completed and executed declaration and releases as required within the time prescribed, prizes will be forfeited, and an alternate potential winner selected. In the event of a dispute regarding who submitted an online entry, the entry will be deemed submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail account. PGE reserves the right to request proof that potential winner is the authorized account holder of the e-mail account.

5. Prizes: Each winner will receive one (1) gift card, to be selected at PGE's discretion, valued at \$50. No alternative prize, cash or other substitution is permitted. All federal, state, and local taxes, fees and duties are the sole responsibility of the winner.

Eligibility: Sweepstakes is open only to persons who are 21 years of age or older and are legal residents of the United States residing in the State of Oregon for the duration of the sweepstakes period. To be eligible to win the sweepstakes, participant must be a PGE customer and must be listed on the PGE account as either the main customer or an authorized user.

Employees, officers, directors and agents of PGE, its parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising, promotion and fulfillment agencies, their immediate family members and persons living in their same household, are not eligible to participate in the sweepstakes.
