



Our collections include upholstery, drapery, curtains and print fabrics in narrow and wide width.



High-quality fabrics with extended-durability properties offer freshness and hygienic cleanliness. Silver ions embedded in the fibre interfere with critical microorganism functions and effectively prevent cell division.

Pure AIR[®] technology is based on mineral salts that are activated in daylight conditions. This technology consists of a mineral based, photo catalyst finishing that is applied to the textile. It permanently reduces pollutants and malodours in the air of your living, sleeping and working surroundings by up to 100 percent. The Pure AIR[®] finish does not wear off from textiles.




wellbeing

This easy-care finish is recommended in hotel and restaurant environments, where textiles contribute to a relaxing atmosphere by reducing noise and spreading warmth and comfort.

Vanelli offers a wide range of IMO certified fabrics designed and tested for the cruise ship industry. Fabrics inherently pass IMO flame code requirements for the cruise ship industry also safety plays an important part therefore the decorative and upholstery fabrics must pass special flameretardancy tests specially developed for shipping. Our IMO fabrics are used in cruise liners, cargo ships, ferries and pleasure boats. Our IMO curtains and IMO sheers meet the major International standards applicable to textiles for use in the interiors, are washable and do not lose their properties with washing. We have a wide selection of IMO flame retardant fabrics for the contract sector.

Vanelli offers a wide selection of DIMOUT-fabrics in a range of designs and textures. Our DIMOUT-fabrics effectively block the light from entering the room. The fabrics meet the highest requirements regarding fire resistance, applicability, colour and light fastness, durability and wear resistance. Vanelli DIMOUT-fabrics feature an elegant drape with a black-out performance of up to 99%.

acoustic fabrics

Vanelli offers a wide range of acoustic fabrics—for a harmonious balance of acoustics and aesthetics. As with light, when sounds hits a surface, part of its energy is absorbed and part is reflected back into the room. So, just as we may install a blind in front of a window to control its brightness, similarly, acoustic solutions are necessary to effectively manage sound and the effect it has upon noise and echo within an interior as it bounces off hard, reflective surfaces. The test report lists the Noise Reduction Coefficient (NRC), which is typically between a range of "1" and "0". If the material achieves a "1", it is said to have 100% absorption (like an open window). If the material receives a "0", it is said to be perfectly reflective. If a fabric has an NRC rating of .65, it means that 65% of the sound energy that contacts the fabric is absorbed, rather than reflected.


our GRS standard

Textiles used for interiors need regular cleaning. Dust and dirt wear down the textiles and their added properties.


