Upholstery fabrics and curtains made of woven fabrics produced from 100% cotton, 100% viscose, 100% linen, 100% LENZING™ Lyocell, 100% silk, 100% wool, reactive yarn dyed, 100% acrylic, basic yarn dyed, 100% polyester, 100% flame retardant polyester (also Trevira®), disperse yarn dyed, viscose(bamboo)/polyester, reactive and disperse yarn dyed (also purple and black mélange) and mixtures among each other with or without metallized yarn, partly washed and silicone or softener finished; woven fabrics produced from 100% cotton, raw white and reactive dyed, cotton/polyester, viscose/polyester, raw white, reactive and disperse dyed; woven fabrics produced from 100% linen, cotton/polyester, viscose/polyester, polyester/viscose, pigment printed, partly with matt white and pearlescent effect, glitter (in colour silver), devoré as well as puff print (in colour white), produced with fibres and finished with products having flame retardant properties and finished with products having biological active properties accepted by OEKO-TEX® as well as water, oil and soil repellent finish; produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class IV** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for decoration material.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
