

Announcement relating to
Turbo Long Certificates
of **Goldman, Sachs & Co. Wertpapier GmbH**
linked to
Continental AG

On 29 April 2021 the spin-off of Vitesco Technologies Group AG was approved by Continental AG's Annual Shareholders' Meeting. Shareholders of Continental AG shall be entitled to receive one Vitesco Technologies Group AG share for every 5 Continental AG shares held. Since 16 September 2021 the Vitesco Technologies Group AG shares are admitted on the Frankfurt Stock Exchange and Vitesco Technologies Group AG is an independent publicly-traded company and the spin-off is effective.

As in the reasonable discretion of Goldman Sachs International as calculation agent for the Turbo Long Certificates (the "**Securities**") an adjustment of the terms and conditions of the Securities is not expected to produce a commercially reasonable result, Goldman, Sachs & Co. Wertpapier GmbH terminates the Securities listed in the table below with effect to 23 September 2021 (the "**Termination Date**") in accordance with the terms and conditions underlying these Securities.

The following termination amount in relation to the Turbo Long Certificates has been determined on the basis of the last price published for Continental AG (ISIN: DE0005439004; Reuters Code: CONG.DE) by XETRA prior to the spin-off on 15 September 2021.
