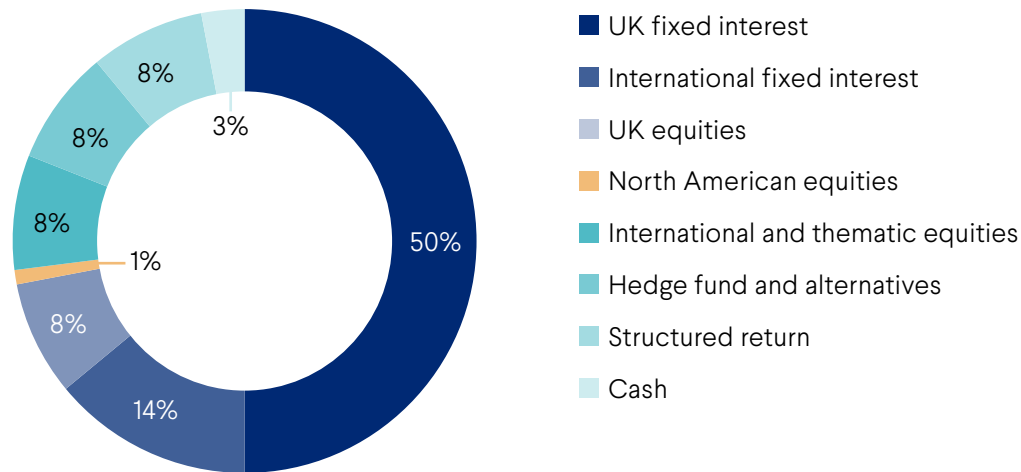

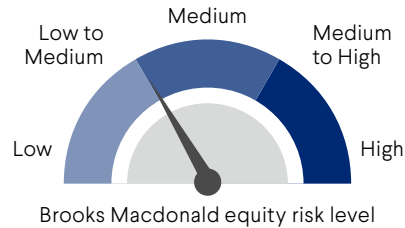
Asset allocation

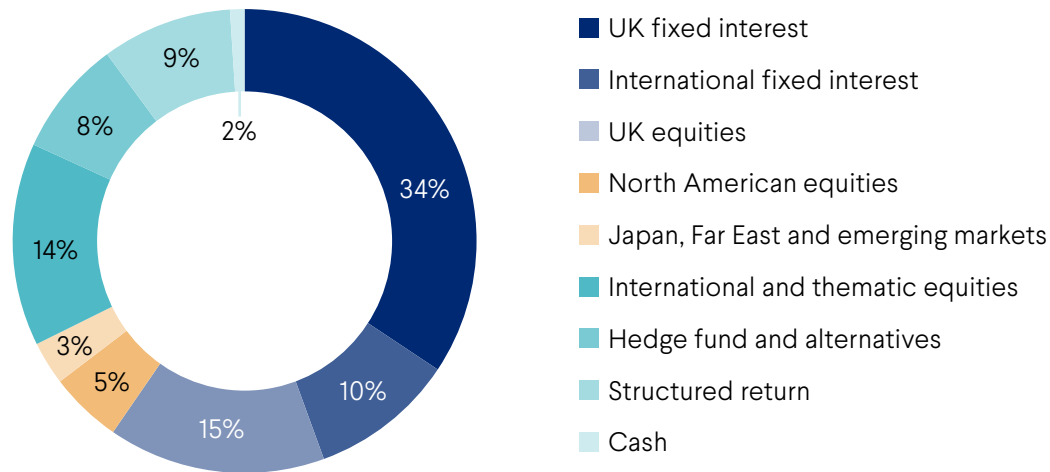

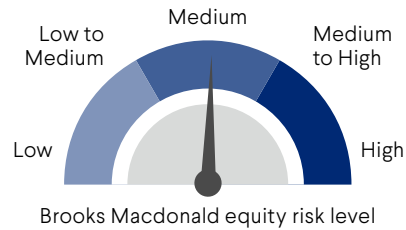

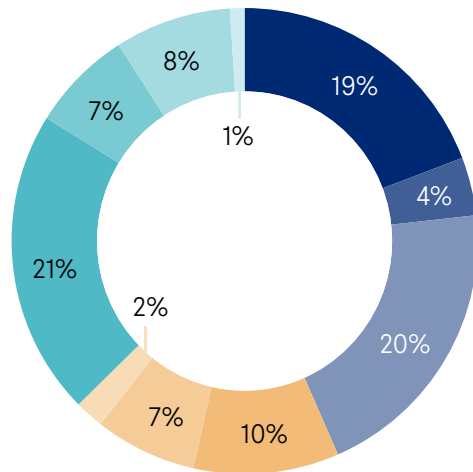

Equity risk level

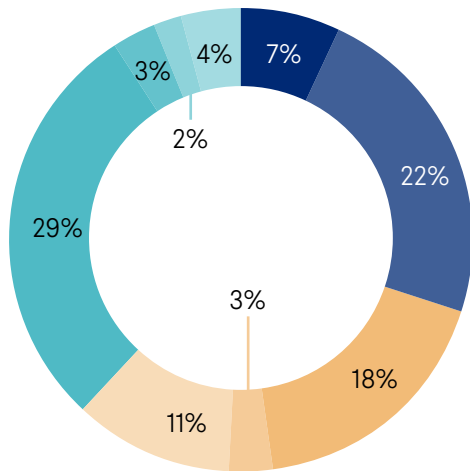

How are the Blueprint MAF constructed?

Our well-established centralised investment process powers the services and products we provide to our clients. This process creates a robust framework for our investment professionals to work together, sharing ideas and challenging each other's views.

The funds are managed using the same investment approach as Brooks Macdonald's discretionary bespoke and managed portfolio services.

The funds benefit from the full breadth and depth of investment expertise within Brooks Macdonald. At its heart, our investment process takes a 'big team' approach. Our investment managers and analysts input into our Centralised Investment Process (CIP). Each Blueprint MAF leverages the broad and varied expertise of our Asset Allocation Committee, Investment Committee and specialist sector research teams. Our asset allocation views and best investment ideas across a broad universe are analysed, debated and refined before being reflected in the Blueprint MAF by their dedicated management team.

Asset allocation

The asset allocation of the funds is determined by our Asset Allocation Committee, which sets the house view across Brooks Macdonald.

We contrast our internal views on the world with those of a range of external parties (for example independent macro research providers and investment banks). We pay most attention to the group that disagrees with us the most, and we bring them into a monthly investment forum to discuss why.

We consider investments from a broad universe of asset classes for inclusion in our multi-asset funds, including regional equities, fixed interest (including government and corporate debt), and alternatives.

Equities are a core growth component of the funds, and within this allocation we seek out investments that we believe will benefit from long-term, structural trends and demonstrate resilience in current and future market conditions – 'thematic' equities. We have a strong background in thematic investing across our range of investment solutions and produce regular commentary around this.

Constructing the funds using a broad spread of different investments ensures that the Blueprint MAF range is widely diversified across geography, sector, and asset type. As is the case with all our funds and discretionary portfolios, we continually review and actively manage the Blueprint MAF range to ensure it holds the optimal mix of assets that we believe will add the best value for investors over the long term.



Investment selection

In terms of underlying investment selection, investment managers across the group are organised into thirteen different sector research teams, each of which specialises in a particular area of the market. This structure allows investment managers to pool their knowledge and experience. It is the responsibility of each sector team to produce a list of recommended investments pertaining to their area of specialisation that are judged to offer compelling investment cases (i.e. the best investment ideas). Recommended investments are then subject to approval by our Asset Selection Committee, before being included on the central buylist.

At every stage of analysis and review, buylist investments are rigorously scrutinised through various rounds of questioning among our wider team of investment professionals. This process leads to constant refining, as our investment ideas are continuously challenged and debated. In addition to financial analysis, environmental, social and corporate governance (ESG) considerations are integrated into our assessment of buylist investments. The multi-asset team select from the buylist to deliver a range of funds constructed using investments that have followed a rigorous due-diligence process. The composition of each fund is carefully monitored on an ongoing basis. Should the market environment or the underlying fund manager experience a change in circumstances, the team are ready to make any necessary changes. They adjust the funds as needed to ensure that they remain on track and in line with the targeted risk levels.

Ongoing monitoring and oversight

In addition to ongoing active management by the multi-asset team, the funds are formally reviewed by the Funds Risk Management Oversight Committee on a regular basis.

Risks that are monitored include (but are not limited to) decisions on asset allocation, fund selection, concentration, liquidity and investment related risk. We also monitor compliance with the Undertakings for the Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) investment and borrowing powers set out in the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) Collective Investment Schemes (COLL) sourcebook.

These rules set out a number of restrictions designed to ensure a prudent spread of risk. The funds are also subject to oversight by the Authorised Corporate Director (ACD), Tutman Fund Solutions Limited.



We produce a full suite of comprehensive, transparent performance reporting for the funds and their respective sector benchmarks on a regular basis.

ESG integration

To us, acting as a responsible investor means we act as responsible stewards of our clients' capital by integrating consideration of Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) factors into our investment process.

ESG issues can be broad and varied:



Environmental – the impact the company has on the environment. Areas of analysis may include carbon emissions, climate related risks, resource depletion (including water, waste management and recycling), pollution, biodiversity loss or deforestation.



Social – the impact the company has on society. Areas of analysis may include human rights, labour rights and standards, inequality, supply chains, local communities, conflicts, health and safety.



Governance – the process by which a company is managed and overseen. Areas of analysis may include executive pay, bribery and corruption, board diversity and effectiveness, shareholder protections and rights, tax strategy, transparency, corporate culture.

We expect managers of the third-party funds we invest in to integrate ESG considerations into their investment decisions, as we believe this helps reduce tail risks and allows our investors to potentially benefit from improved risk adjusted returns.

When selecting funds, we conduct due diligence on the managers' approach to incorporating ESG factors into their investment decisions as well as their stewardship activities. We have developed a structured framework for ESG research processes and integration which incorporates input from qualitative questionnaires, third-party ESG data and fund manager meetings. We do not use third-party ESG data as a screen, instead it is used to highlight areas for further qualitative investigation in four key categories: controversies, carbon related risks, product involvement in controversial weapons and overall ESG risk management.

We expect fund managers to identify and effectively manage ESG related risks in their portfolios and where our research identifies concerns that this might not be the case, we will engage with fund managers - if we are not satisfied with responses, we will not invest. We also conduct ongoing due diligence to ensure fund managers continue to meet our expectations. The funds we can invest in span a variety of asset classes including equity, fixed interest, property and alternatives as well as passive and active strategies. We are mindful that levels of ESG integration vary across the different asset classes, and we take this into account in our research.
