There is no Request for Proposal (RFP) Associated with this Notice.

Lottery Equipment Spare Parts (908) NOI LOT #1407

Introduction

This is a Notice of Intent (NOI) announcing the Massachusetts State Lottery Commission's (MSLC's) intention to seek spare repair parts from GTECH Corporation, 10 Memorial Boulevard, Providence, Rhode Island, 02903, unless another qualified bidder(s) can provide the exact product specified (approximately 1,800 spare repair parts). MSLC intends to contract for spare repair parts for the Lottery's betting terminals, Express Point terminals, and Instant Ticket Dispensers as manufactured by GTECH Corp. Bidder(s) must have legal access to all spare repair parts as specified in this NOI (see Attachment C). This notice seeks only responses from qualified bidders(s) who can offer the exact product (specified spare repair parts) at a more competitive cost structure and have complete knowledge of the product as applied in the MSLC environment.

Purpose of Procurement

The MSLC is seeking spare repair parts for the Lottery's betting terminals, Express Point terminals and Instant Ticket Dispensers as manufactured by GTECH Corp, 10 Memorial Blvd, Providence, Rhode Island, 02903. Approximately 1,800 spare repair parts are supported by this contract. Bidders must have legal access to all spare repair parts as specified in this NOI. The MSLC reserves the right to add/delete parts as needed.

Warranty

Required ninety (90) days from date of receipt by the MSLC.

Delivery

A packing slip must accompany all deliveries. The packing slip must include the contract number, the quantity of the items shipped, and a description of the item. In addition, all correspondence must show the contract number. No delivery will be accepted without a packing slip. The trucking or courier receipt is not an acceptable packing slip.

Refer to Attachment C - Spare Repair Parts Listing

Bidder(s) **must** provide the spare repair parts as listed in Attachment C, as needed, including shipping to: MSLC, 60 Columbian Street, Braintree, MA 02184. The MSLC makes no guarantee that any commodities will be purchased from any contract resulting from this NOI.

Anticipated Expenditures

The expenditure associated with this solicitation is anticipated to be approximately \$750,000.00 for Fiscal Year (FY) 15 (July 1-2014 – June 30, 2015) and approximately \$750,000.00 for FY16 (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016). The purpose of this requisition is to bridge the gap between the current terminal(s) and the deployment of a new terminal(s), which is projected to begin in 2015.

Anticipated Duration of Service

The resulting contract is anticipated to be for the period of two (2) years commencing on the



resulting contract start date.

Important

Bidders must be able to provide the exact product specified (approximately 1,800 spare repair parts) for the Lottery's betting terminals, Express Point terminals, and Instant Ticket Dispensers as manufactured by GTECH Corp. Bidder(s) must have legal access to all spare repair parts as specified in this NOI (see Attachment C). Bidders must also have legal access to, and complete knowledge of, the spare repair parts.
