The Executive Director reserves the right to amend this Administrative Bulletin if he deems it is in the best interest of the Lottery to do so.

The effective date of the Administrative Bulletin shall be January 5, 2026

Bruins Ticket Giveaway Promotion

Official Rules

1. GENERAL: By participating in the Massachusetts State Lottery's Bruins Ticket Giveaway Promotion (the "Promotion"), which is sponsored by the Massachusetts State Lottery Commission (the "MSLC"), located at 150 Mt. Vernon Street, Dorchester, MA 02125, the entrant acknowledges and agrees to all these Official Rules. The purpose of this promotion is to promote and encourage the sale of Massachusetts State Lottery products and to advertise the Lottery's sponsorship of the Boston Bruins professional hockey team ("Bruins") in accordance with the terms of Bruins MSLC Sponsorship Agreement dated December 10, 2025. The entry period of the Promotion begins on Monday, January 5, 2026 at approximately 5:00 a.m. and ends Thursday, April 2, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. with weekly drawings to take place on the Friday at 9:00 a.m. of each week for 13 weeks. The initial draw will occur on or about Friday, January 9, 2026, and the final draw will occur on or about Friday, April 3, 2026, pursuant to clause 13 herein. All times in the Promotion refer to Eastern Time (ET). By participating in the Promotion, entrants agree to be bound by the Official Rules and by all decisions of the Executive Director of the Lottery, which decisions are in his/her sole discretion, are binding and final. Failure to comply with the Official Rules may result in disqualification from the Promotion.

2. ELIGIBILITY: The Promotion is open to all persons who are 18 years of age or older. Employees of the Lottery and their family members, including spouse, child, brother, sister or parent residing as a member of the same household as their principal place of abode, are not eligible to enter or win.

3. HOW TO ENTER: There is one (1) method of entry ("Entry") for the Promotion in which qualified entrants must follow: Entrants must use the link provided on the dedicated promotion page at <http://www.masslottery.com> and complete the Woobox entry form. Eligible entrants are Lottery players who have created a valid account on the Lottery mobile app or a MA Lottery Player Account using the same email for both the Promotion and the MA Lottery Player Account. Entrants must provide their name, email address, valid mailing address, zip code, city/town,

phone number, confirm that they are 18 years of age or older, and verify their acceptance of the Official Rules and Regulations. Entrants may opt-in to receive emails from the Lottery, but are not required to do so to enter the Promotion. Limit one entry per person. Only one (1) entry is valid for the Promotion and will be valid for each remaining drawing during the Promotion, unless a prize is won which shall complete the players participation in the promotion. Any additional entry(ies) shall be disqualified from entry into the remaining drawings and disqualified from the winner pool. Entries for the Promotion shall only be considered an eligible entry if received within the Entry Period.

4. SELECTION OF WINNERS: One (1) winner shall be randomly selected by the Lottery from all eligible entries received during the entry period. There is a total of one (1) winner per each weekly drawing respectively, and a total of 13 winners for the Promotion. There will be an additional five (5) entries selected as alternate winners in the event that a winner is disqualified, does not accept the prize, or does not respond within the time allotted for response, as provided herein. Winners shall be selected using the Woobox application through its random selection tool from valid entries submitted. The entry period shall begin on Monday, January 5, 2026 at or about 9:00 a.m., with weekly drawings to take place on the Fridays thereafter for the following 13 weeks at or about 9:00 a.m., with winners to be announced on the same Friday, on or about 12:00 p.m. by posting the name of the winners on the Lottery's website at www.masslottery.com and through Lottery Instagram and Facebook account. To be eligible for a Friday drawing, the entry must have been submitted by or before 11:59 p.m. the preceding day. Any entry submitted after the close of any entry period is entered into the next remaining drawing, excluding the final entry period. The first drawing will be conducted on or about Friday, January 9, 2026 at approximately 9:00 a.m. with the winners to be announced on or about Friday, January 9, 2025 at 12:00 p.m. Winners will be contacted by the Lottery via telephone on Friday after the draw using the telephone number and emailed using the email address submitted on the contest entry form. Winners will have 72 hours from the time of the Lottery's initial contact to respond and accept the prize in writing. If the selected winner does not respond to the Lottery's initial contact within 72 hours, or if prize notification is undeliverable, not accepted, or in the event of any noncompliance with any of the Official Rules, the prize may not be awarded, and the Lottery may select an alternate winner. It shall be the sole responsibility of each entrant to notify the

Lottery if his/her contact information changes. The Lottery is not responsible for false, incorrect, changed, or incomplete information. Each entrant may win one (1), and only one (1), prize during the Promotion.

5. PRIZES: The total number of prizes available to be awarded for each respective drawing shall be one (1). Each winner will receive two (2) tickets to attend one (1) Bruins game at TD Garden located at 100 Legends Way, Boston, MA 02114. The date of the game is predetermined, and the Lottery will not replace or exchange the tickets with tickets to another game to be played on a different date. There are no physical tickets. All tickets will be digital and sent from the Lottery's Ticketmaster account to the winner's Ticketmaster account. Unless the winner already has an account established, winners must create a Ticketmaster account via Ticketmaster.com immediately after winning the prize. Once the player's account is established, the Lottery shall forward the winner two (2) tickets digitally through the Ticketmaster platform. All applicable federal, state and local taxes, if applicable, expenses, fees or costs associated with the prize shall be the sole responsibility of the winners.

6. CANCELLATION/ FORCE MAJEURE: The MSLC shall not be responsible for any or all cancellations, nor to replace or exchange any tickets for acts that are beyond the control of the MSLC such as the Bruins game is cancelled any time prior to the commencement of the game, whether the game is re-scheduled or not, if the winner fails to show up to the game for which the winner was awarded tickets by this promotion, or any other reason beyond the control of the MSLC.

The MSLC shall not be responsible for failure to perform its obligations if it is prevented from or delayed in performing those obligations by an event of force majeure. An event of force majeure are acts of God, including severe acts of nature or weather events, including floods, fires, earthquakes, hurricanes and explosions; acts of government, including expropriation, condemnation, changes in laws and / regulations, strikes or labor disputes, travel restricts and / or epidemics; and / or any other acts that are inadvisable, commercially impracticable and / or impossible to perform for 30 days or more, whether emergencies or non-emergencies related to any event herein.

7. DRAW PROCEDURES: All entrants that have submitted an entry during the promotion period will be part of a random drawing, using the Woobox application's random selection tool

from the valid entries submitted. There will be 13 drawings during the Promotion. Drawings will take place on or about each Friday at 9:00 a.m. as follows on January 9, January 16, January 23, January 30, February 6, February 13, February 20, February 27, March 6, March 13, March 20, March 27, and April 3. Winners from all drawings held January 9 through February 13 will win tickets to attend the Bruins game on February 26 at TD Garden, 100 Legends Way, Boston, Massachusetts. Winners from all drawings held February 20 through April 3 drawings will win tickets to attend the Bruins game on April 14 at TD Garden, 100 Legends Way, Boston, Massachusetts. In the event that any winner is disqualified, or the prize is undeliverable, the next sequential alternate from the same drawing shall be added to the winners list, and each alternate from the same drawing shall move up the list in sequential order. All drawings will take place as described herein unless there is a technical, legal or other issue which may prevent or delay the drawing, subject to the provisions herein or as may be determined in the sole discretion of the Executive Director. Any delay shall be posted on the MSLC website at www.masslottery.com.

8. ODDS OF WINNING: Odds of becoming a winner of the Promotion are dependent on the total number of valid eligible entries received during the entry period.

9. PRIVACY: Personally identifiable information that is submitted by an entrant, if any, as part of the Promotion shall be used by the Lottery to administer the mobile app, the Lottery Player Account and the Promotion, select the prize winners, and fulfill the prizes, and will be treated in accordance with the Lottery's privacy policy, accessible at:

11. 12. DISCLAIMER: By entering the Promotion, the entrant is entered into the Promotion for that respective entry period. The entrant assumes all risk and liability for any personal injury or damages caused or claimed to be caused by, arising out of or in connection with his/her participation in the Promotion and/or the acceptance and/or use of any prize, and hereby indemnifies, holds harmless and releases the Lottery, its respective constitutional office, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, agents, and employees from any and all such liability. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the Treasurer and Receiver General, the Lottery, its commissioners, directors, agents and employees of any of the foregoing are not responsible for technical, hardware, software, or cellphone malfunctions of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections, or failed, incorrect, incomplete, inaccurate, garbled or delayed electronic communications caused by the user or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Promotion. By participating in the Promotion, the prize winner grants permission to the Lottery to use the winner's name, city, state, likeness and/or voice, biographical information and photo submission, if any for purposes of advertising, promotion, publicity, including all social media platforms without compensation of any kind.

13. NON-PERFORMANCE: If the Promotion is not capable of running as planned for any reason, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, and unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Lottery which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity of the game or Promotion, the Lottery may cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Promotion. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the Treasurer and Receiver General, the Lottery, its Commissioners, directors, agents and employees of any of the foregoing (i) assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay, in operation or transmission, in any manner, or communications failure, theft, destruction or unauthorized access to or alteration of entries, (ii) are not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of Woobox and/or any mobile networks, any telephone or cellphone networks, computer on-line systems, servers or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any email to be received by the Lottery due to technical problems, human error, or traffic congestion, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to the

entrant or any other person's mobile phone or device related to or resulting from participation in the Promotion. If, in its sole discretion, the Lottery determines that an entrant failed to abide by these Official Rules or uses or attempts to use the program or the MA Lottery's Player account in a manner other than for its intended purposes, the MA Lottery Player's account may be suspended or terminated at the direction of the Executive Director.

14. DISPUTES/CHOICES OF LAW: Except where prohibited, each entrant agrees that (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Promotion or any prize awarded shall be brought and are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, (2) any and all claims, judgements and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event attorneys' fees, (3) punitive, incidental, special, consequential or other damages, including without limitation lost profits may be awarded (collectively "Special Damages") and (4) entrant hereby waives all rights to claim Special Damages and all rights to have such damages multiplied or increased. Massachusetts General Laws, without reference to Massachusetts' choice of law rules, governs the Promotion and all aspects related thereto.

15. MISCELLANEOUS: The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of the Official Rules or the required documentation is otherwise unenforceable or illegal, all other provisions will remain in effect and will be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained therein. Entrants agree to waive any rights to claim ambiguity of these Official Rules. Headings are solely for convenience of reference and will not be deemed to affect in any manner the meaning or intent of the documents or any provision thereof. In the event there is a discrepancy or inconsistency between disclosures or other statements contained in any Promotion related materials, privacy policy, and / or the terms and conditions of the Official Rules, the Official Rules shall govern and control, and the discrepancy shall be resolved in the Lottery's sole and absolute discretion. Certain features of the Promotion may utilize the services or products of third parties and participation in the Promotion may require entrants to utilize such features and agree to additional terms and conditions.
