Legislation Act 2019: Revision Programme for 54th Parliament

Portfolio **Attorney-General**

On 20 June 2024, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 **noted** that the Legislation Act 2019 requires the Government to systematically revise New Zealand's Acts to make legislation more accessible, readable, and easier to understand without changing the substantive effect of the law;
- 2 **noted** that the Attorney-General is required by section 95 of the Legislation Act 2019 to prepare a three-yearly programme of statute revision for each new Parliament that must be presented to the House of Representatives as soon as practicable after the Government has approved it;
- 3 **noted** that the Attorney-General has prepared, and consulted publicly on, the revision programme for the 54th Parliament, as attached to the paper under LEG-24-SUB-0124;
- 4 **approved** the revision programme for the 54th Parliament.
