VARIETY:DelicaTYPE /COLOUR:Kabocha (Green)DAYS TO MATURITY:100WEIGHT (KG):1.7-1.9

Delica is a variety that is extremely adaptable to various growing conditions. The fruit has a superb, sweet taste and a dark green skin finish with a flat globe shape and thick yellow flesh.



VARIETY: Constanza TYPE / COLOUR: Kabocha (Green)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 120 WEIGHT (KG): 1.0-1.2

This superb Kabocha type produces high yielding and uniform fruit with a very intense taste and an attractive speckled green skin structure.

Constanza is an early maturing variety with excellent long storage capabilities.



VARIETY: Sweet Mama TYPE / COLOUR: Kabocha (Green)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 120 WEIGHT (KG): 1.8-2.0

Sweet Mama is extremely high yielding and heavier than Delica. This semi bush type variety has good storage capabilities, short internodes, and a delicious nutty taste.

VARIETY: Delica Sun TYPE / COLOUR: Kabocha (Orange)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 100 WEIGHT (KG):

This is the new Phytorich Delica which has all the advantages of the Standard Delica, but with a flat round shape and an attractive orange coloured skin The fruit has the same sweet taste as the Standard Delica but with internal flesh of a curry to orange colour. Bred conventionally in Japan by Takii this variety's Phytorich nutrient is Lutein (UK proven) at a high concentration of 10mg/100g.



VARIETY: Uchiki Kuri TYPE / COLOUR: Kabocha (Orange)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 40 WEIGHT (KG):

1.0-1.5

Uchiki Kuri is a high yielding variety with a vigorous plant habit. The tear drop shaped fruits are extremely attractive with a vibrant deep orange external skin. The flesh is a creamy colour with a delicious, sweet and nutty flavour.



VARIETY: Delica Moon TYPE / COLOUR: Kabocha (Grey)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 85 WEIGHT (KG):

2.0

This is another new Delica type which also has all the standard variety's advantages in taste, texture and uniformity but with a relatively smooth and attractive grey skin colour with the characteristic flat globe shape and intensely yellow to orange flesh. Delica Moon produces good yields over a range of soil types and climatic conditions.



VARIETY: TI-126 F1 TYPE /COLOUR: Kabocha (Green Acorn)

DAYS TO MATURITY: 55 WEIGHT (KG):

1.6-1.8

This is a uniquely shaped Kabocha type. TI-126 is very similar to Acorn Squash but has all of the advantages of the Delica types in terms of taste, flesh texture and a good thick skin which helps to reduce product handling damage. It is a fast-maturing variety in the similar range to Uchiki Kuri which means that it can be harvested from Mid/Late August to December.
