Convergence is the global network for blended finance. We generate blended finance data, intelligence, and deal flow to increase private sector investment in developing countries. <u>Blended finance</u> is the use of catalytic public or philanthropic capital to increase private sector investment in places that need it most. Convergence's global membership includes public, private, and philanthropic investors as well as sponsors of transactions and funds. Convergence offers its members a curated, online platform to connect with each other on blended finance transactions in progress, as well as exclusive access to original market intelligence and knowledge products such as case studies, reports, training, and webinars. To accelerate advances in the field, Convergence also provides grants through its <u>Design Funding</u> program, for the design of vehicles that could attract private capital at scale. Convergence plays an important role in driving investment to close the estimated \$2.5 trillion gap in funding per year for the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The Data & Research Intern will be primarily focused on building up Convergence's database of blended finance transactions, collecting new data through desk research, and developing data analysis tools (e.g., reports, dashboards, data visualizations, comp sets) for Convergence members. This is a unique opportunity for someone who is interested in learning more about the development finance landscape while gaining qualitative data management experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Data & Research Intern will be based in Toronto, working closely with the Member Content team. Key activities will include:

- Qualitative desk research on closed blended finance transactions
- Data cleaning and management, including data validation and additional desk research
- Qualitative and quantitative data analysis and written reports (e.g., research briefs, dashboards, data visualization, and competitive sets)

Through these activities, the Data & Research Intern will develop stronger research and analysis skills, with an emphasis on qualitative data management and analysis, and an in-depth understanding of blended finance in developing countries.
