Convergence is the global network for blended finance. We generate blended finance data, intelligence, and deal flow to increase private sector investment in developing countries. [Blended finance](#) is the use of catalytic public or philanthropic capital to increase private sector investment in places that need it most. Convergence's global [membership](#) includes public, private, and philanthropic investors as well as sponsors of transactions and funds. Members include institutions such as MacArthur Foundation, FinDev Canada, the Nature Conservancy, and Credit Suisse. Convergence offers its members a curated, online platform to connect with each other on blended finance transactions in progress, as well as exclusive access to original market intelligence and [knowledge](#) products such as case studies, reports, training, and webinars. To accelerate advances in the field, Convergence also provides grants through its [Design Funding](#) program, for the design of vehicles that could attract private capital at scale to global development.

Convergence is headquartered in Toronto and is currently seeking a Data & Research Intern.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Data & Research Intern will be primarily focused on building up Convergence's database of blended finance transactions, collecting new data through desk research, and developing data analysis tools (e.g., reports, dashboards, data visualizations, comp sets) for Convergence members. This is a unique opportunity for someone who is interested in learning more about the development finance landscape while gaining qualitative data management experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Data & Research Intern will work closely with the Member Content team. Key activities will include:

- Collecting and coding qualitative data on blended finance transactions, including building out 1-3 new data fields
- Supporting qualitative desk research on closed blended finance transactions, including to support knowledge products produced by Convergence (e.g., case studies, data briefs)
- Performing data cleaning and management, including on member data validation requests as needed and additional desk research

Through these activities, the Data & Research Intern will develop stronger research and analysis skills, with an emphasis on qualitative data management and analysis, and an in-depth understanding of blended finance in developing countries.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE

- Full-time post-graduate or undergraduate student returning to university in Fall 2020 (expected graduation in 2021 or 2022)
- Pursuing a degree in Economics, Business, Public Policy, International Relations, Science, Math, Engineering or a related field
- Excellent academic record
- Data management experience (e.g., database management, data governance)
- Data analysis and visualization, including the ability to present information in an insightful and structured manner
- Understanding of development finance, economic development, and/or structured finance
- Experience working with Salesforce valued but not required
