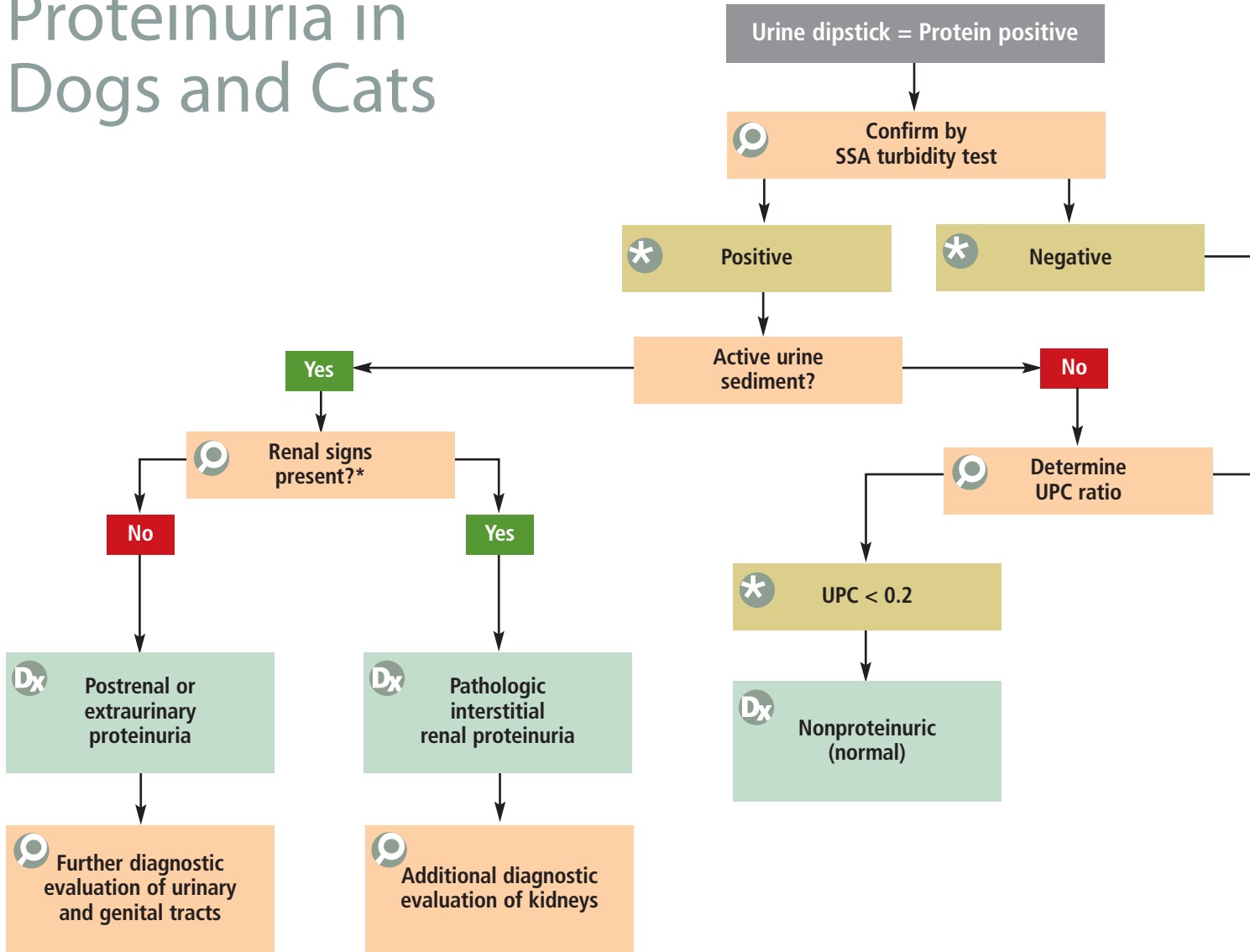

* Renal signs, such as pyrexia, painful kidneys, or kidney failure, suggest probable renal involvement. However, most urinary tract infections, including renal infections, occur in absence of these signs (identified here as postrenal or extraurinary proteinuria).
