

Drilling Manual

Drilling into the ceiling is not permitted in the entrance hall or the bathroom, as these are suspended ceilings.

Electrical conduits with live wiring are typically embedded in a vertical line above and below electrical switches and outlets. A safety distance of 15 cm must be maintained on both sides of the installation.

Mounting in and around the bathroom

The illustration is a schematic drawing of the bathroom marked in red; the layout may therefore vary from one apartment to another. Drilling into the walls in the bathroom or in the walls adjacent to the bathroom (e.g. from the entrance hall or kitchen, marked with crosses) is not permitted.

The water supply to mixer taps is typically provided through pipes embedded vertically in the wall above and below the tap. Avoid mounting fixtures in these areas. If the tenant chooses to disregard these guidelines, they will be held financially liable.
