Shelfology

Yo, let's go! Position shelf on the wall with the pre-drilled holes along the top edge. Align screw holes with as many studs as possible. Use your drill to screw in either far left or right hole.



Level the shelf and set second screw in opposite end screw hole with your drill. If you've already installed blocking behind the length of the backbar, skip to Step 5. For more intel on blocking, see Rad Tip #1 below.

While the shelf is mounted to the wall, mark every remaining empty screw hole with a pencil.

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Remove the shelf from the wall to install wall anchors in each marked location that is not on a wall stud or blocking. Predrill each wall anchor location with ¼" drill bit to avoid breaking wall anchors.



Replace the shelf, drill screw into each screw hole.



Make your final inspection of the shelf. Check for shelf sag, confirm the shelf is correctly secured to wall. If your shelf is sagging, refer to Rad Tip #2



Stand back and relax, you did it! Give your cat a celebratory fist bump, if present. Gently place your Golden Girls[™] box collection on shelf and admire!

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Rad Tip #1 Blocking refers to pieces of wood or other material that run between wall studs in order to provide support and attachment sites for your shelf.



Rad Tip #2 If your wall is not straight, use shims to ensure your shelf is installed straight across the wall face and square to the wall.



**WARNING: Shelves must be correctly installed into studs or wall blocking. Failure to do so may result in sagging shelves, falling objects, or serious injury.
