



On Lok's 30th Street Senior Center in San Francisco Unveils New 850 Sq. Ft. Garden Mural With Precita Eyes Muralists

[On Lok's 30th Street Senior Center](#) in Noe Valley unveils its new 850 sq. ft. garden mural in partnership with [Precita Eyes Muralists](#) on Saturday, July 13. This is one of a series of events to commemorate the Center's 40th anniversary this year. Considered a "second home" by its seniors, the Center is the largest multi-purpose senior center in San Francisco. It is part of On Lok's family of services supporting the independence of older adults across the Bay Area.

Muralists Susan Cervantes and Miranda Bergman worked with the senior community at 30th Street to create a design that reflects the rich history of the Center, its wide variety of services/activities and its inclusive and welcoming atmosphere. The resulting sketch has been brought to life on the 850 sq. ft. wall in the Center's colorful garden. This mural replaces a previous iteration, which was created in 2003.

Established in 1977, Precita Eyes Muralists is a community-based organization that seeks to educate people about community art. The 30th Street Senior Center mural speaks to the myriad ways seniors' lives are positively impacted by the Center every day.

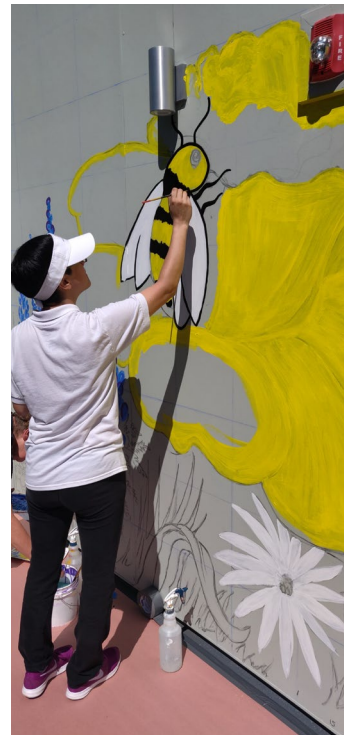
