## People and Places of the Roman Past

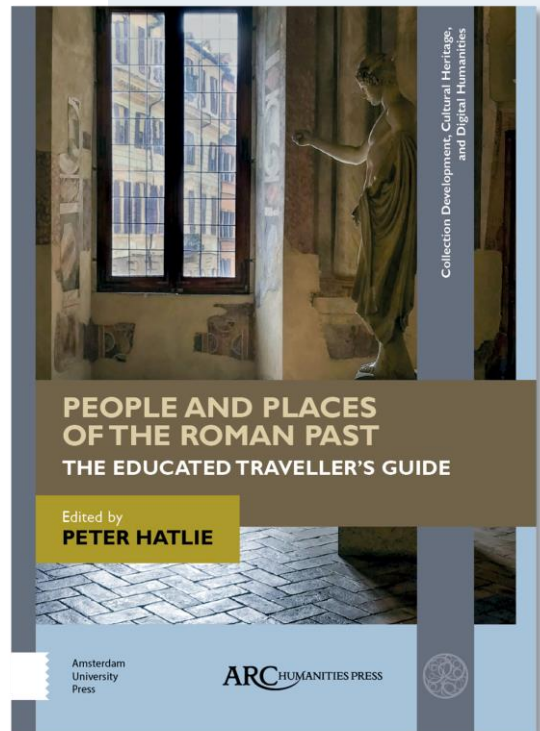
*The Educated Traveller's Guide*
