Aims and scope

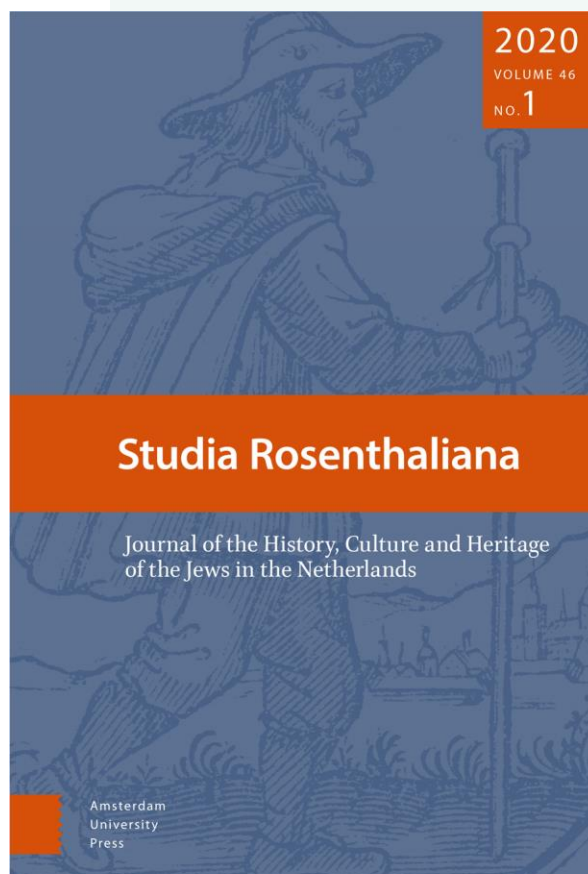
