Sociologie aims to be an academic platform for social scientific research written in Dutch. The journal is particularly focussed on research on current societal affairs and problems. It is convinced of the importance and added value for both society and academia of a flourishing sociological debate in Dutch language.

Sociologie publishes three issues a year, including a yearly special issue in which a broad range of specialists writes about a key sociological theme at the invitation of the editorial board. In the beginning of 2016, Sociologie became the first Dutch sociology journal that is completely available in Gold Open Access.

Sociologie is the result of the merger (in 2005) between two highly respected Dutch journals in the field of the social sciences: Sociologische Gids and Amsterdams Sociologisch Tijdschrift.

Sociologie publishes both articles with a theoretical and an empirical focus, based on both quantitative and qualitative research. The articles and essays published in this journal are written for a broad and interdisciplinary audience. Next to scientific research and book reviews, the journal also functions as a platform for debate on the role of sociology in Dutch society
