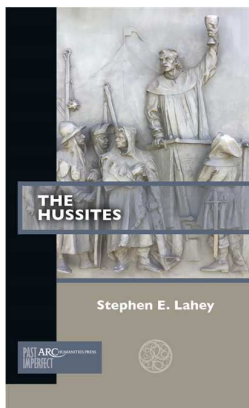
READERSHIP

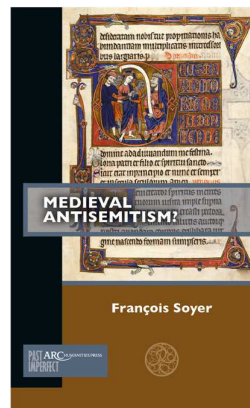
ABOUT ARC HUMANITIES PRESS
