## NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Yachting New Zealand Prescriptions 2017-2020 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.4 Discretionary Penalties: After a protest a boat that is found at fault may be given a discretionary scoring penalty by the protest committee. The scoring penalty shall be no greater than 30% calculated as stated in Rule 44.3.

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. [DP]

### 3 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES



- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Feva Class.
- 3.2** Each competitor shall be:
- (a) a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority;
  - (b) a member of their Class Association.
  - (c) Under 19 years of age 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 except for where a parent may sail with a son or daughter
- 3.3** All Eligible competitors shall enter online by 1800hrs **Wednesday 14<sup>rd</sup> October 2020** at [www.maraetaisailingclub.org.nz](http://www.maraetaisailingclub.org.nz) Credit/Debit Card payment is required.
- 3.4** The entry fee is **NZ\$70** per boat and must be paid online at the time of Entry.
- 3.5** Late entries may be accepted at the Organising Authority's discretion until 1800hrs on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020** with the entry fee of **\$95**.

- 4.2** Equipment inspection: Spot Checks by Class Measurers may take place at any time during the regatta

- 4.5** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day will be advised at the morning briefing.

## **7 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

- 7.1** The courses used will be Windward / Leeward or Trapezoid.

## **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 8.1** For the **RS Feva** class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. A one turn penalty will be used (including a tack and a gybe)

## **9 SCORING**

- 9.1** One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**9.2**

- a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When five (5) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- c) When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

**10 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be deemed to be “Event Support Boats” and shall have an operative VHF radio and follow all instructions of the Race Officer.

**11 PRIZES**

Prizes may be awarded to the first three in each class or division.

**12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat is advised to be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of NZ\$1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

**13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
