### Notice of Race

---

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.
- 1.2 Yachting New Zealand Prescriptions 2017-2020 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply.
- 1.4 RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 Appendix T will apply.

- 1.6** Immediately after finishing, a boat intending to protest shall, in addition to the requirements of rule 61.1(a), inform the race committee on the finish boat of her intention to protest and the identity of the boat(s) protested against. The protesting boat must receive an acknowledgement from the race commit. This changes Rule 61.

## **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority in accordance with World Sailing Reg 20, Advertising code.

## **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the 29'er and 420 classes.
- 3.2** Normal entries close at 1700 on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> January.
- 3.3** Entries should be made using the entry form on the website [Auckland Champs 2019 Entry](#)  
On Line entry will open on Friday 21 December 2018.
- 3.4** Late entries accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$100 per boat may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.  
  
No entries will be accepted after 1900 hours on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January.
- 3.5** To be eligible to compete each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority. Each New Zealand sailor competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by Yachting New Zealand.
- 3.6** Each entrant and crew member shall be financial members of the respective New Zealand Class association or an association affiliated to the respective International Class Association.

## 8 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall meet class measurement requirements. The 29'er class will be subject to measurement checks. Measurement for 29'er class will be on Friday from 12 noon to 1700.

## 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta website [www.maraetaisailingclub.org](http://www.maraetaisailingclub.org) 14th January. Sailing instructions will not be distributed at the regatta.

## 10 VENUE

The race course area will be in the Tamaki straits off Maraetai beach.

## **11 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be:

29'er            Windward / Leeward.

420             Trapezoid with outer loop.

## **12 PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.

## **13 SCORING**

**13.1** 3 Races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

### **13.2**

- a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- c) For the 29'er Class only when 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

## **14 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats movements will be subject to restrictions that will be specified in the sailing Instructions.

## **15 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

## **16 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each class.
