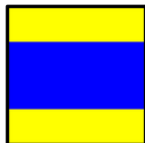

Description of Port-End Starting Mark: Orange flag on orange buoy to the Port side of the Committee boat		
Description of Other Finish Mark: A Blue flag on the Finish Boat and a Blue flag on an orange buoy to the port side of Finish Boat. There will be a separate Finish Boat/Finish line between the bottom mark (Mark 5) and the Committee boat/Start line – See Course diagrams.		
Description of Change of Course Mark: Replacement Buoy – Yellow SIMB		
Courses: Starlings – Course I Trapezoid with inner loop and beat to finish Optimists – Course O Trapezoid with outer loop and beat to finish See course sheets		
Number of Races required to Constitute a Series: One		
Combined fleets: P-Class (if any) and Optimist Open fleets will start together but be scored separately. The warning signal will be the “Optimist Open” class flag.		
Starting Sequence of First Races of First Day (detail for each course if applicable): Optimist Green, Optimist Open, Starling		

Launch/Haul out Restrictions:

Boats to launch from the Maraetai Reserve. MSC Boats may launch from the Northern Ramp in the club grounds.

Launching - Flag D with a sound signal means: 'the warning signal will be made not less than 15 minutes after flag D is displayed.' Boats shall not go afloat until this signal (Flag D) is made.

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Additional Sailing Instructions

- **Change 4.1 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
...“ change to the Sailing Instructions or Regatta Specific Schedule will be posted before **1130 hours** on the day it will take effect...”
- **Change 6.6 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
...“no warning signal will be made after **1630 hours.**”
- **Change 15.1 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
...“ **For ALL Classes:** Target Time is **30 minutes**, Time Limit is **45 minutes** and the Mark 1 Time Limit is **15 minutes** ...”
- **Change 15.2 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
...“If no boat has passed Mark 1 within **15 minutes**, the Race Committee **can** abandon the race...”
- **Change 15.3 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
...“Boats failing to finish within **15 minutes** after the first boat sails the course and finishes...”
- **Change 16 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12, to read:**
“16. Still Racing Score does not apply.”
- **Change 17.2 of the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2017 v11, to read:**
...“the protest time limit will be **60 minutes**...”
- **Add 17.9 to the Standard Sailing Instructions Version 2018 v12:**
17.9 Immediately after finishing, a boat intending to protest shall, in addition to the requirements of rule 61.1(a), inform the race committee on the finish boat of her intention to protest and the identity of the boat(s) protested against. The protesting boat must receive an acknowledgement from the race committee. This changes rule 61.
