Safe Non-Prescription Medicines During Pregnancy

We want to help you stay happy and healthy during your pregnancy. There may be times during your pregnancy when you feel like you need over-the-counter medicines.

We have listed over-the-counter medicines that are safe for pregnant women. Follow the instructions on the package for the correct dose. **Do not take NSAIDs** (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs) such as ibuprofen and naproxen.

Common Conditions and Treatments

Cough or Sore Throat

- Plain Robitussin cough syrup (guaifenesin)
- All cough drops
- Chloraseptic Sore Throat Spray (phenol)

Cold, Sinus Congestion, Allergies

- Chlor-Trimeton (chlorpheniramine)
- Claritin (loratadine)
- Zyrtec (cetirizine)
- Saline nasal spray

Constipation

- Pericolace (sennosides/docusate) or Colace (docusate)
- Metamucil (psyllium)
- Fibercon (polycarbophil)
- Milk of Magnesia (magnesium hydroxide)
- MiraLAX

Diarrhea

• Imodium (loperamide)

Headache

- Plain Tylenol (acetaminophen)
- Extra Strength Tylenol

Heartburn or Indigestion

- Tums
- Maalox
- Mylanta
- Rolaids
- Gaviscon (calcium carbonate)
- Pepcid AC (famotidine)
- Axid AR (nizatidine)

Hemorrhoids

- Preparation H (phenylephrine/hydrocortisone)
 - o Cream
 - o Ointment
 - o Gel
 - o Pads
 - Suppositories
- Anusol (hydrocortisone)
- Tucks pads (witch hazel)
- Americaine (benzocaine)
- Non-medicated sitz baths

Insomnia

- Benadryl (diphenhydramine)
- Unisom (doxylamine)
- Tylenol PM

Nausea

- Ginger lollipops
- Vitamin B6 25-50 mg three times daily
- Unisom (doxylamine) ½ tablet twice daily
- Benadryl (diphenhydramine)

Vaginal Itching

• Monistat 7 (miconazole)
