# What to Expect at Your Pin Removal Visit

#### Step 1

Bring a dose of pain medicine with you. Give it to your child while you are waiting.

### Step 2

We will cut the cast with a cast saw. This saw is just for cutting casts and will **not** cut your skin.



### Step 3

We will take x-rays to check for healing and confirm that the pins are ready to be removed.

#### Step 4

We will remove the pins. This does not take long. This may be uncomfortable or painful for you.

# Step 5

We will place a splint for protection and comfort. We may use your cast to make this splint.
