

BEACH VOLLEYBALL

REGULATIONS

I. TIME AND PLACE

From May 17 to May 18, 2025. Olympic training Center Vierumäki, Heinola. Address Pihkalantie 3, 19120 Vierumäki.

II. PARTICIPANTS

There will be men's (max 14 teams) and women's (max 14 teams).

Each team will consist of 2 players and 1 coach (during the match, the coach cannot lead the team). The exact tournament system, draw and timetable will be published after the registration. The competition will be held according to the international (FIVB) beach volleyball rules. Competitions will be played in group's round robin system followed by play-off phase. At least two best ranked teams according to match points of each group will qualify for play-off rounds. The race will be conducted in groups (lap/modified) system.

A set (except the deciding 3rd set) is won by the team which first scores 21 points with a minimum lead of two points. In the case of a 20-20 tie, play is continued until a two-point lead is achieved (22-20; 23-21; etc). In the case of a 1-1 tie, the deciding 3rd set is played to 15 points with a minimum lead of 2 points.

Team gets 2 match point for won match, 1 point for lost match and 0 points for withdrawn match. In the case of a tie in the pools (match points) at the end of the round robin, the following rules will apply:

- The team with higher rally point's ratio in the matches between all teams in the pool, is ranked higher.
- Between three or more teams: if a tie still exists, then the team with higher rally point's ratio in the matches between the tied teams in the pool, is ranked higher.
- Between two teams: if a tie still exists, then the winner of head-to-head match is ranked high.

The organizers reserve the right to change the system of conducting the competition.

All competing participants must meet the requirements of the General Regulations of **SELL Student Games** 2025.

III. MEDICAL SERVICE

The participants must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are not the responsibility of the OC. The OC will insure the first aid at the competition venues for all accredited persons.
