MORE Family Collection (MFC) is a fourth-generation family business, which owns and manages a private group of award-winning, luxury safari lodges, boutique hotels, and private residences set within some of Southern Africa's finest locations. *[Refer MORE Destinations]*

Our origin dates to 1933 when our great grandfather Guy Aubrey Chalkley purchased the land that Lion Sands Game Reserve was later established on. We now have four luxury lodges at Lion Sands.

Our footprint is in five unique safari reserves, and our hotels in the vicinity of two Natural Wonders of the World.

Our properties include Lion Sands Game Reserve (Mpumalanga), Marataba Game Lodges and Monwana Game Lodge (Limpopo), Cape Cadogan Boutique Hotel and More Quarters Neighbourhood Hotel (Cape Town),

We are committed to protecting the environment, community development, sustainability principles, and delivering on our purpose of creating life-enriching experiences for our guests.

MORE Family Collection is headed up by Custodian and CEO Robert More, who is supported by a team of dedicated and talented people. We appreciate that every day we have the opportunity to create experiences for our guests that inspire a new appreciation of life – their own and the natural world – allowing us to continue conserving the regions' wild places for generations to come.

More Community Foundation

More Community Foundation is the non-profit organisation through which the MORE Family Collection group delivers our corporate, social and environmental responsibilities in Southern Africa. All community projects for social development are self-sustainable, as it is our belief that by supporting communities to contribute their own efforts and skills, projects are kept alive into the future. Socially inclusive conservation is critical to biological diversity and the Foundation strives to achieve community collaboration and custodianship within all conservation projects.

Our Board of Trustees includes a MORE Family Collection representative, an environmental education and community representative, a NPO and community development advisor, and a legal and governance advisor.

Development projects in place are designed around five pillars, supporting:

- Education and Skills Development – we support early childhood development, primary and high school education, tertiary education, and training (in ICT, Nature Conservation & Hospitality), as well as adult skills development through community-based learning programmes.
- Enterprise Development – we facilitate the development of local black businesses and provide MORE Family Collection-supported enterprise opportunities to drive demand and enable local trade.
- Improving Living Standards – we support the provision of basic human needs to improve our communities' quality of life and ensure their well-being, with a focus on providing access to security, basic healthcare, proper sanitation and clean, running water.
- Access to Clean, Running Water – we support access to clean, running water through the installation of solar-powered or renewable energy-powered boreholes in our most underprivileged communities.
- Conservation & Human Wildlife Mitigation – the care and protection of the earth's natural environment and resources for future generations that includes the planned management of natural resources, maintaining diversity of species, genes, and ecosystems, as well as the natural functions of the environment using community-based conservation, environmental education and supporting human wildlife conflict mitigation where possible.

MORE Field Guide College

What would a safari be without the experienced field guides and trackers leading you right to the action and providing insightful commentary? Many of our guides have been trained at our own MORE Field Guide College, a Field Guide Association of Southern Africa (FGASA) Training Delivery Partner. FGASA (Field Guide Association of Southern Africa) maintains the highest standards for guiding throughout the region and is a registered provider with CATHSSETA (South Africa's Culture, Art, Tourism, Hospitality, and Sport Sector Education and Training Authority). FGASA sets high standards in the industry, with their qualifications recognised across Africa and in the USA, UK and UAE.

MORE Field Guide College is based at our Marakele National Park and produces field guides of an exceptional calibre, offering both full-length and short courses providing them the opportunity to attain their NQF2 Nature Site Guide (FGASA) certificate. Graduates then have the option of entry into a more advanced course or an internship at a luxury safari lodge, setting them on the right track to a guiding career.

Our second campus in the Greater Kruger National Park region, is the result of a collaboration with the More Community Foundation, and the Timbavati Foundation. In its first year of official operation in 2023, 23 community students from nearby communities on a one-year course sponsored by Tshikululu Trust and enabled by Anglo American Platinum, graduated and did their 6-month placement. The second intake in July 2023 had a total of 33 community students. This is part of our commitment to addressing unemployment and building of skills in South Africa.

The founding of MORE Field Guide College was inspired by passionate conservationist Nick John More (1967–2013) and initially named NJMORE Field Guide College. It fulfils his wish to continue the legacy of three generations of More nature ambassadors, unwavering in their dedication to safeguarding our environment and passionate about sharing their profound affection and knowledge of the planet's last untouched places. Therefore, students are chosen for their authentic and unmistakable love for the wilderness and their capacity to kindle the same enthusiasm, in individuals from across the globe.

A reverence for the environment informs teaching of how safaris are to be conducted. The Collection's guiding culture teaches a balanced approach to human presence and ecosystem health, and never to cause undue stress to the animals.

Our MORE Field Guide Standards Board steers our journey to foster a culture that inspires field guides and positions MORE Field Guide College as an industry leader in ethical, exceptional, and professional field guiding.

In the bush, near natural wonders, by the ocean, and in the city – this lets us share with our guests the region's many attractions and gives them a synergised experience of the best this side of the continent has to offer.

Some of our properties are part of the More family heritage – tremendous gifts, handed down through generations of custodians. Others took time and patience to curate, and great passion to transform into the very special and singular places they are today. But we consider each of our properties a second home, and this is how we want our guests to enjoy them.

Our MORE Family Collection Lodges, Hotels, and Residences provide places for loved ones and friends to come together, and with every comfort and convenience afforded, there is time for the rest to take care of itself... During this pause, our commitment is to creating experiences that when shared, reconnect guests with themselves, each other, and the 'wonder-fullness' of life.

LION SANDS GAME RESERVE, SOUTH AFRICA

Lion Sands is the only private reserve rooted in both the Sabi Sand Nature Reserve and Kruger National Park. The Sabie River forms a natural boundary between its two sides, and four waterside lodges provide the ultimate luxury safari bases. Ivory Lodge and River Lodge are located on the Sabi Sand side, and over on Kruger are Narina Lodge and Tinga Lodge. The animals roam freely between them, and no matter which side guests choose to stay on, they will have exceptional game-viewing opportunities. Lion Sands conserves 12 400ha (30 600ac) of a habitat that is home to the highest and most diverse concentration of wildlife in the southern hemisphere. Natural animal populations include all the Big Five, and the reserve is renowned for the quality of its leopard viewing – normally the most elusive of predators.

- Lion Sands Kruger National Park is one of only seven private park concessions and protects pristine wilderness, as well as sites of cultural and historical significance
- Lion Sands Sabi Sand forms part of Sabi Sand Nature Reserve – the oldest private nature reserve in South Africa, established in 1948, with our grandfather as one of the founders, instilling a legacy of community and conservation
- Exceptional, FGASA-accredited MORE Field Guides
- All four lodges are within 12km (7mi) of Skukuza Airport
- Ivory Lodge is one of only 11 properties in the country to be awarded 5 Star Premium status by the Tourism Grading Council of South Africa
- Ivory Lodge and River Lodge specifically cater for Jewish guests with various kosher catering options
 - Gourmet kosher cuisine is always freshly prepared on-site

River Lodge offers a *connection-rich safari* with 18 rooms and social areas like the outdoor fire deck, veranda and bar area to gather and catch up on the day. The lodge has a chic design interpretation of the traditional safari lodge with contemporary décor and limited walls that create a flow between interior and exterior with a sense of brightness and space. Wooden walkways connect the main lodge to a spa, a gym and pool. There are eight Luxury Rooms, six Superior Luxury Rooms (two sets with interleading rooms), and four River Suites our most spacious and private. Each of the River Suites has a private plunge pool, with one of the River Suites ideally suited for families with two bedrooms. All our Rooms and Suites are set along the path revealing splendid river views.

Narina Lodge is a place *nurturing natural beauty*. Perched on stilts under a canopy of 100-year-old trees just up from the water, Narina Lodge offers guests a wonderful sense of remoteness and peace, and panoramic views of the Sabie River from the main lodge or one of the nine private luxury suites. Like the Narina Trogon bird after which it is named, the lodge is astonishingly beautiful, yet blends unassumingly into the natural environment.

Tinga Lodge is the *classic safari experience*, with a focus on the senses. Nine luxury suites capture the romance of the pioneer era, in considerably more comfort. Set apart on a high bank up from the Sabie River, each Suite is privately set with its own plunge pool and deck overlooking the water making the most of a view that often sees wildlife passing through. There is also a spa sala, the main lodge with its bar lounge, library, guest pool and boma offering spaces to enjoy the company of others, or some personal quiet moments. Our Treehouse circuit encompasses Lion Sands Game Reserve and Marataba:

- Lion Sands Sabi Sand: Chalkley Treehouse (sleeps 2 adults) and Kingston Treehouse (sleeps 2 adults and 2 children, 10–14 years) for guests of River Lodge and Ivory Lodge

- Lion Sands Kruger Park: Tinyeleti Treehouse (sleeps 2 adults and 2 children, 10–14 years) for guests of Narina Lodge and Tinga Lodge
- Marataba: Thabametsi Treehouse (sleeps 2 adults and 2 children, 10–14 years) for guests of Marataba Safari Lodge and Marataba Mountain Lodge

Guests pack a stay-over bag, leaving their room at the lodge behind, and are driven by their field guide to their remote hideout. Guests arrive at sunset to a private gourmet picnic and can spend the dusk hours spotting wildlife out in the bush, before falling asleep under the stars.

Each treehouse is securely constructed above the ground, where the animals remain at a safe and comfortable distance. The field guide will also provide a full orientation before he departs, but will remain on radio call, until pick up the following morning, after a good breakfast.

A night in a Treehouse is booked in conjunction with guests' lodge accommodation. They do not check out of their room or suite – it remains available should they wish to return at any point. As such, this experience is charged for at a per person per night rate, over and above the lodge rate.

Please note: Stays are weather dependant, except possibly in Kingston Treehouse
