

What are the UiPath Al25 Awards?



The annual UiPath Al25 Awards recognize the 25 most innovative UiPath customers using a combination of Al and automation as a strategic change enabler to accelerate bigger and bolder outcomes. Al and automation are redefining what's possible—not just in business, but in the ways we work and live. This powerful combination creates fast, comprehensive, and actionable insights to inform decisions—uncovering never-before-seen opportunities for productivity and innovation.

The Al25 Awards honor customers that are using Al and automation to transform the way they are doing business—from supercharging productivity and transforming customer and employee experiences to delivering substantial returns on investment or supporting corporate environmental, social, and governance (ESG) initiatives. They will determine the winners based on a defined set of criteria. Submission Guidelines



- UiPath customers may nominate themselves or be nominated by a third party. If you are a third party
 nominating a customer, please ensure you've received the necessary approvals from the customer prior to
 submitting a nomination.
- Responses must be written in English.
- We recommend preparing your submission in a document and then copying and pasting the submission into the entry form.
- You will need a business email address to save your progress while filling out the nomination, upload supporting files, and submit the entry form. Please direct any questions to Al25awards@uipath.com.
- The entry submission deadline is August 7, 2024, at 11:59 pm PT.
- Include a company logo (in color and in black and white) in a vector file (.ai, .eps, or .svg only).
- Eligible entries must reflect current UiPath customers with implementations that occurred between July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2024. Entries must demonstrate larger, transformational business outcomes beyond individual use cases. If you submitted an entry for a prior awards year, you may submit it again if you are able to demonstrate continuous improvements and business impact for the time period subsequent to the previous entry.
- All responses in the entry form must be complete and include current contact information for the person submitting the entry and the customer contact(s) who approved the submission.
- Entry form details, customer company name, and names of customer's employees provided in the entry form are subject to use in UiPath marketing and communications materials, including but not limited to press releases, case studies, blogs, media outreach, awards nominations, and more.

- How did you prioritize use cases and where to start and expand?
- Did you start in one area of business or across departments? How did that evolve?

- How was the UiPath Business Automation Platform critical to enabling your Al use case(s) and achieving your goals?
- How has your AI and automation initiative changed your business?
- · How have customers, employees, shareholders, and the broader community been impacted?
- How has your AI and automation deployment delivered results such as supercharging productivity, transforming customer and employee experiences, seeing substantial returns on investment, supporting corporate ESG initiatives, etc.?
- What were the specific results?
- What can you achieve now that you weren't able to before?

UiPath Al25 Awards FAQ



- Who is eligible to participate? All current UiPath customers are welcome to nominate implementations that have occurred between July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2024.
- If my company submitted for the awards last year, can we apply again this year? Yes, all customers are welcome to apply again, provided you can demonstrate improvements or updates to the results you submitted last year.
- When is the submission deadline? The submission deadline is August 7, 2024, at 11:59 pm PT.
- When will the winners be selected and announced? Winners will be judged and selected after the submission deadline of August 7, 2024. Winners will be notified in September 2024 and officially announced at UiPath FORWARD + TechEd, taking place in Las Vegas on October 21–24, 2024.
- What are the selection criteria and how will the winners be selected? Twenty-five winners will be selected based on their use of Al and automation leveraging the UiPath Business Automation Platform to supercharge productivity, transform customer and employee experiences, deliver substantial returns on investment, and/or support corporate ESG goals. Winners will also be selected based on how they are innovating with GenAl and automation. Winners will be evaluated and selected by a judging panel of UiPath leaders and third-party Al and automation experts. All decisions are final. UiPath reserves the right to modify or terminate any Al25 Award at any time at its sole discretion.
- What will Al25 Award winners receive? In addition to being recognized by one of the leading Al and automation companies, Al25 Award winners will be announced in a UiPath press release and at UiPath FORWARD. Award winners will also receive a promotional toolkit to elevate the win across their own channels and a trophy to honor their success.

2024 UiPath Al25 Awards Rules & Regulations



The objective of this contest is to recognize the best solution(s). For purposes of this contest, "solution" means a UiPath Business Automation Platform capability or implementation that: (i) uses the most recent versions of UiPath technologies; (ii) solves customer pain points or a related business problem; and (iii) supports improved business performance and industry innovation.

Applicants will be asked to describe their successful implementation of a solution and how that solution added business value. For purposes of this contest, each "solution" you create will be called an "entry." Each eligible entry received will be judged based on how compelling and comprehensive it is.

All applicants are required to have approval to serve as references for UiPath. This includes mentions of the company and its UiPath Al and automation story in press releases (with customer review prior to publication) and at least one interview with a media outlet. Other potential opportunities include speaking at FORWARD or other UiPath events, analyst interviews, featured logo on UiPath website, etc. Please confirm with all relevant parties (including your communications and legal teams) that you are permitted to serve as a media reference for UiPath before submitting your application.

UiPath is not responsible for entries that it does not receive for any reason, or for entries that we receive but are not decipherable for any reason. We will automatically disqualify any incomplete, unclear, or unverifiable entry, as well as any entries that exceed any word limit described above. All entries must be submitted in English.
