

DMCA Policy

UiPath is committed to respecting the intellectual property rights of others and we expect our customers, users and partners to comply with the same standards. This Policy is read together with the agreement between us and the end user/customer/partner (“you”) and the other applicable terms and conditions available on our website (“ToU”).

DMCA Recourse

The Digital Millennium Copyright Act (“DMCA”) provides recourse for copyright owners who believe that material appearing on the internet infringes their rights under U.S. copyright law. If you’d like to check it out, the DMCA is available on the U.S. Copyright Office website at <http://www.copyright.gov/legislation/dmca.pdf>.

We have put in place a process of responding to clear notices of copyright infringement consistent with the DMCA. If you believe in good faith that materials available within UiPath products or services infringe your or a third party’s copyright, you may ask us to remove or block access to such materials, by sending an e-mail to us at legal@uipath.com with the following details and meeting the DMCA applicable requirements:

1. “Report Abuse Copyright Infringement” in the subject filed of the e-mail;
2. a description of the copyrighted work(s) claimed to have been infringed;
3. a description of the material you claim to be infringing or the subject of the infringing activity, and information that could allow us to locate the material in our products or services;
4. the following statements “*I hereby declare that use of the material in the manner presented above is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law*” and “*I hereby represent that this notification is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that I am, or I am authorized to act on behalf of, the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed in the material*”;
5. your name, address, telephone number and email address; and
6. a physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or a person authorized to act on the owner's behalf.

Please consult your legal advisor before filing a notice, noting there can be penalties for false claims under the DMCA.

If we find the allegations to be correct, we may remove the offending material and warn the user who posted it. We reserve the right to suspend or disable the accounts of users who repeatedly mislead others or violate any third-party intellectual property rights.

Intellectual Property Compliance

During the term of the ToU, we expect you to comply with all intellectual property applicable law and not misuse any third-party intellectual property right, including pertaining to UiPath.
