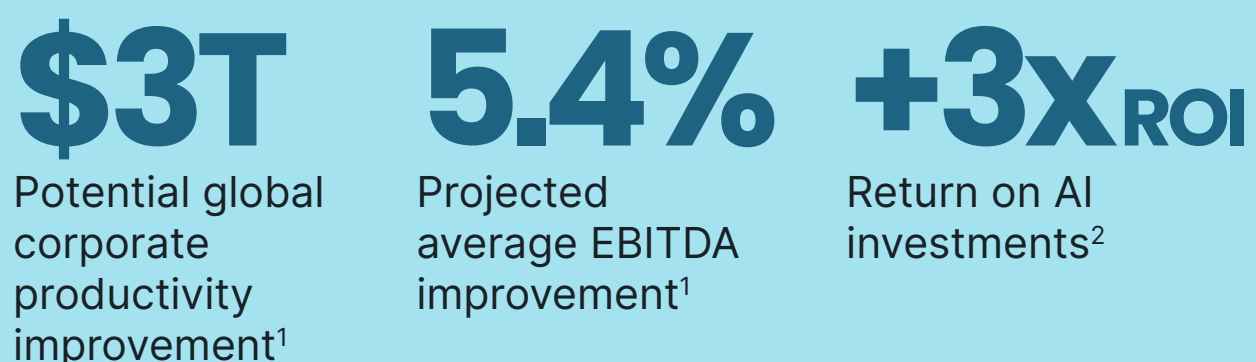

The agentic age promises vast new value for enterprises, but capturing it requires agentic business orchestration.

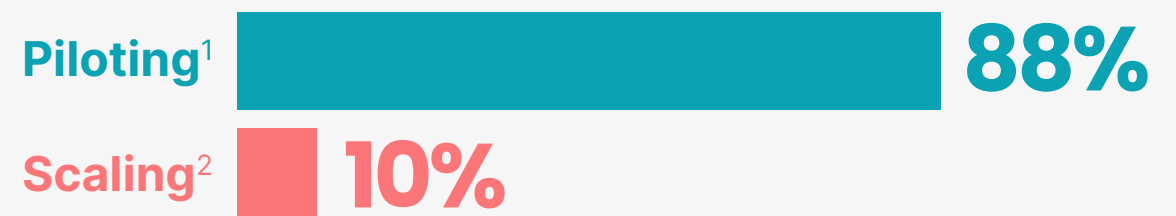
The size of the agentic prize for AI leaders...

Running business processes with AI agents, automation, systems, and people requires new operational capabilities. Here's what you need... and how UiPath agentic business orchestration delivers it.

Coordinate end-to-end workflows.

Running thousands of autonomous processes at once, each with its own dependencies, decisions, and handoffs, is highly complex. But it needn't be chaotic.

Orchestration brings everything into sync by triggering work, routing tasks to the right participants, and managing how it all flows together.

Keep long-running processes on track.

Processes inevitably get interrupted, handed off, or put on hold. When agents or people pick them up again, they need to know how to move forward.

Orchestration ensures durable execution for every process, so agents and people have the context to take effective action.

Provide governance and guardrails.

Agents need boundaries. And you need to know they're staying inside them.

That's why consistent and coordinated control is critical. It enables organizations to enforce guardrails, execute runtime controls, and ensure human-in-the-loop oversight.

Observe and audit.

Without real-time visibility into agents' activities across every workflow, you're flying blind. (Not a good look for agentic operations.)

Orchestration keeps track of every agent and every workflow with ongoing monitoring, execution logs, and full audit trails.

Handle exceptions and recovery.

In a world where processes hardly ever run clean and clear, you need to be able to easily handle exceptions—without exception.

That means having capabilities to automatically detect problems, retry and re-route work, and escalate for review when necessary.

Provide enterprise-wide connectivity.

If agents can't get into systems and applications, invoke tools, or collaborate with other parties, they can't get their work done.

Orchestration provides full enterprise integration and connects agents to the workflows, tools, and systems they need.
